BERNAT RIPPLE AND RIDGE KNIT BLANKET | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat® **Beyond**™ (4.2 oz/120 g; 80 yds /73 m)

Contrast A Cream (23004) 7 balls Contrast B Slate (23003) 4 balls Contrast C Pumpkin (23009) 4 balls

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 40" [101.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly) **Cont** = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern **Rep** = Repeat **RS** = Right side **St(s)** = Stitch(es)

 $\mathbf{Yo} = \mathbf{Yarn} \ \mathbf{over}$

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50½" x 60" [128.5 x 152.5 cml.

GAUGE

12 sts and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A: 20 rows. With B: 20 rows. With C: 20 rows.

These 60 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A cast on 139 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 8 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is RS.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows: **1st row:** (RS). K4. *K1. yo. K4.

(K2tog) twice. K4. yo. Rep from * to last 5 sts. K5.

2nd row: K4. Purl to last 4 sts. K4.

Last 2 rows form pat.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in pat as established until 200 rows of Stripe Pat have been completed.

With A, knit 8 rows (garter st). Cast off.
