**MEASUREMENTS**

50 x 65 ins [127 x 165 cm].

**MATERIALS**

**Bernat® Super Value**

**Harvest Colors** (197 g / 7 oz)

**Main Color (MC):**

**3 balls** (#53521 Rustic Heather)

**1 ball** each of:

**Contrast A:** (#53015 Taupe Heather)

**Contrast B:** (#53014 Steel Blue Heather)

**Contrast C:** (#53241 Moss Heather)

**Contrast D:** (#53309 Plum Heather)

**Contrast E:** (#53203 Teal Heather)

**Contrast F:** (#53522 Redwood Heather)

Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles **or**  
**size needed to obtain gauge.** Cable  
needle.

**GAUGE:** 18 sts and 24 rows = 4 ins  
[10 cm] in stocking st.

**STITCH GLOSSARY**

**KB1(2)** = Knit into back of next 1 (2) st(s).

**PB1(2)** = Purl into back of next 1 (2) st(s).

**T2B** = Slip next stitch onto a cable  
needle and leave at back of work. KB1,  
then P1 from cable needle.

**T2F** = Slip next stitch onto a cable  
needle and leave at front of work. P1,  
then KB1 from cable needle.

**MB** = (Make bobble). [(K1. yfwd) twice.  
K1] all in next stitch. **Turn.** P5. **Turn.**  
K5. **Turn.** P2tog. P1. P2togtbl. **Turn.**  
Sl1. K2tog. pss0.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

**Stripe Pat:** Work 10 rows of each color  
in following sequence: A, B, C, D, E, F,  
work 4 rows of MC. These 64 rows  
form Stripe Pat.

**Strip A** (make 1): With MC, cast on  
45 sts.

Knit 7 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is  
WS.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). Knit.

**2nd row:** K1. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.

\*\*First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.  
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last  
2 rows until work from beg measures  
approx 61½ ins [156.5 cm], ending with  
10 rows of any color.

With MC, knit 7 rows (garter st). Cast off  
knitwise (WS).\*\*

**Strip B** (make 1): With MC, cast on  
45 sts.

Knit 7 rows, noting 1st row is WS.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). Knit.

**2nd row:** K1. Purl to last st. K1.

Rep from \*\* to \*\* as for Strip A.

**Strip C** (make 1): With MC, cast on  
45 sts.

Knit 7 rows, noting 1st row is WS.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). Knit.

**2nd row:** K7. Purl to last st. K1.

Rep from \*\* to \*\* as for Strip A.

**Strip D** (make 2).

With MC, cast on 50 sts.

Knit 7 rows, noting 1st row is WS.

Proceed in Pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). K2. P3. [P5. (KB1. P1)  
twice. KB2. (P1. KB1) twice. P5] twice.  
P3. K2.

**2nd row:** [K10. (PB1. K1) twice. PB2.  
(K1. PB1) twice] twice. K10.

**3rd row:** K2. P3. [P5. (KB1. P1) twice.  
MB. (KB1. P1) twice. KB1. P5] twice.  
P3. K2.

**4th row:** As 2nd row.

**5th row:** K2. P3. [P4. (T2B) 3 times.  
(T2F) 3 times. P4] twice. P3. K2.

**6th, 8th, 10th, 12th and 14th  
rows:** K2. Knit all knit sts and PB1 all  
purl sts as they appear to last 2 sts. K2.

**7th row:** K2. P3. [P3. (T2B) 3 times.  
P2. (T2F) 3 times. P3] twice. P3. K2.

**9th row:** K2. P1. [P4. (T2B) 3 times.  
P4. (T2F) 3 times] twice. P5. K2.

**11th row:** K2. P4. [(T2B) 3 times. P6.  
(T2F) 3 times. P2] twice. P2. K2.

**13th row:** K2. P3. [(T2B) 3 times. P8.  
(T2F) 3 times] twice. P3. K2.

**15th row:** K2. P3. KB1. P1. MB. P1.  
KB1. P10. (KB1. P1) twice. MB. (KB1.  
P1) twice. KB1. P10. KB1. P1. MB. P1.  
KB1. P3. K2.

**16th row:** K5. [(PB1. K1) twice. PB1.  
K10. (PB1. K1) twice. PB1] twice. K5.

**17th row:** K2. P3. [(T2F) 3 times. P8.  
(T2B) 3 times] twice. P3. K2.

**18th, 20th, 22nd and 24th rows:**  
As 6th row.

**19th row:** K2. P4. [(T2F) 3 times. P6.  
(T2B) 3 times. P2] twice. P2. K2.

**21st row:** K2. P5. [(T2F) 3 times. P4.  
(T2B) 3 times. P4] twice. P1. K2.

**23rd row:** K2. [P6. (T2F) 3 times. P2.  
(T2B) 3 times] twice. P6. K2.

**25th row:** K2. P3. [P4. (T2F) 3 times.  
(T2B) 3 times. P4] twice. P3. K2.

**26th row:** As 2nd row.

Rep 3rd to 26th rows for pat until work  
from beg measures same length as Strip  
A, ending with a WS row. Cast off.

**FINISHING**

Pin strips to measurements. Cover with  
a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew Strips in following sequence: A, D,  
B, D, C using flat st.
