

# BERNAT BIG BASKETWEAVE BLANKET | KNIT



#### **MATERIALS**

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) or 5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m) Mallard Wood (10203) or (00203) 1035 yds/940 m or 5 (10) balls

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

**Approx** = Approximate(ly) Pat = Pattern

**Beg** = Begin(ing) **Rep** = Repeat(ing) **St(s)** = Stitch(es) **Cont** = Continue(ity)  $\mathbf{K} = Knit$ **WS** = Wrong side

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$ 



## **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 56" x 60" [142 x 152.5 cm].

## **GAUGE**

8 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Cast on 112 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needles in rows, knit 8 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS.

Proceed in pat as follows:

**1st row:** (WS). K8. \*P8. K8. Rep from \* to last 8 sts. K8.

2nd row: Knit.

3rd to 12th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows 5 times more. **13th row:** K8. \*K8. P8. Rep from \* to last 8 sts. K8.

14th row: Knit.

**15th to 24th rows:** As 13th and 14th rows 5 times more.

Last 24 rows form Basketweave Pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 58" [147.5 cm], ending on

a 12th or 24th row of pat.

Knit 8 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).
