

BERNAT® SLIP STITCH BLANKET | KNIT



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52" x 60" [132 x 152.5 cm]

GAUGE

8 sts and 9 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 115 sts. **Do not join.** Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

1st row: (RS). *K3. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

2nd row: *K3. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: *K3. P1. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

Rep last 4 rows for Slip St Pat until Blanket measures approx 59" [150 cm], ending on a 1st or 3rd row of pat.

Knit 4 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Sonoma (10018)

5 balls

Size U.S. 15 (10 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly)

K = Knit

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1P = Slip next stitch purlwise

Sl1Pwyif = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side
