## 7 balls

Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) circular knitting needle 36 " $[91.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Locking ring stitch markers.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $43 \times 55$ " $[109 \times 139.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGE

13 sts and 17 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Tuck St Panel Pat (worked over 17 sts) (see Chart on page 3)
1st row: (RS). K2. P1. Place first marker on last st. K7. P1. Place second marker on last st. K6.


Pat = Pattern
Rep $=$ Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS = Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

2nd to 6th rows: Beg on a purl row, work 5 rows in stocking st.


7th row: (RS - tuck row). K6.


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Insert left-hand needle from WS through 2 vertical bars of first marked st 6 rows below.


K2tog (picked up 2 bars and next st).


K3. P1. Place marker on last st. K3. Insert left-hand needle from WS through 2 vertical bars of second marked st 6 rows below. K2tog (picked up 2 bars and next st). K2.


8th to 12th rows: Beg on a purl row, work 5 rows in stocking st. 13th row: (RS - tuck row). K2. P1. Place first marker on last st. K3. Insert right-hand needle from WS through 2 vertical bars of marked st 6 rows below. Slip these 2 bars onto left-hand needle. K2tog (picked up 2 bars and next st). K3. P1. Place second marker on last st. K6.


14th to 18th rows: Beg on a purl row, work 5 rows in stocking st. Rep 7th to 18th rows for pat.


Cast on 149 sts. Do not join in rnd. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: 1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd and 3rd rows: *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
4th row: As 1st row.
Rep these 4 rows for Moss St pat twice more.

Proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). (K1. P1) 4 times. P1. *Work 1st row of Tuck St Panel Pat. P1. (P1. K1) 9 times. P2. Rep from * twice more. Work 1st row of Tuck St Panel Pat. P1. (P1. K1) 4 times.
2nd row: (P1. K1) 4 times. K1. *Work 2nd row of Tuck St Panel Pat. K1. (K1. P1) 9 times. K2. Rep from * twice more. Work 2nd row of Tuck St Panel Pat. K1. (K1. P1) 4 times.
3rd row: (P1. K1) 4 times. P1. *Work 3rd row of Tuck St Panel Pat. P1. (K1. P1) 10 times. Rep from * twice more. Work 3rd row of Tuck St Panel Pat. P1. (K1. P1) 4 times.
4th row: (K1. P1) 4 times. K1. *Work 4th row of Tuck St Panel Pat. K1. (P1. K1) 10 times. Rep from * twice more. Work 4th row of Tuck St Panel Pat. K1. (P1. K1) 4 times.
Tuck St Panel pat and Moss St pat are now in position.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 58 " [147.5 cm], ending on 8th or 14th row of Tuck St Panel Pat.
Work 12 rows in Moss St pat. Cast off.

Double Wrap Tassels (make 12): Wrap yarn around a 10" [25.5 cm] piece of cardboard 30 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across opposite end. Wrap yarn 6 times around tassel $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}[4 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] from tied end and fasten securely. Wrap yarn 6 times around tassel $23 / 4$ " [ 7 cm ] from tied end and fasten securely. Attach 6 tassels evenly spaced across top and bottom edges of Blanket.
