MATERIALS

Bernat[®] Crushed Velvet[™] (10.5 oz/300 g; 315 yds/288 m) Soft Gray (16001) **4 balls**

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) Susan Bates[®] Silvalume[™] circular knitting needles 40″ [101.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

together
M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up
horizontal loop lying before next

Psso = Pass slipped stitch over
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Sp = Space
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yo = Yarn over

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 58" [127 x 147.5 cm].

GAUGES

15 sts and 25 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 162 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 10 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS.

Next row: (WS). K4. *M1. K7. Rep from * to last 11 sts. M1. K11. 184 sts. Proceed in pat as follows: **1st row:** (RS). Knit. **2nd row:** K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5. **3rd row:** K6. *SI1. K3, then psso 3 knit sts. Rep from * to last 6 sts. K6. **4th row:** K5. P1. *P3. yo. Rep from

* to last 6 sts. P1. K5. Rep last 4 rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 56" [142 cm], ending on a 1st row. **Next row:** (WS). K4. *K2tog. K6.

Rep from * to last 4 sts. K4. 162 sts. Knit 10 rows (garter st). Cast off.
