MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket Extra™ (300 g/10.5 oz; 97 yds/87 m)

Faded Blues (27036)

6 balls

Size U.S. 17 (12.75 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52" x 61" [132 x 155 cm]

GAUGE

5 sts and 7 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 66 stitches (sts). Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. *Purl 3 (P3). Knit 3 (K3). Repeat (Rep) from * to end of row.

2nd and alt rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear. 3rd row: P2. *K3. P3. Rep from * to

last 4 sts. K3, P1.

5th row: P1. *K3. P3. Rep from * to last 5 sts. K3. P2.

7th row: *K3. P3. Rep from * to end of row.

9th row: K2. *P3. K3. Rep from * to

last 4 sts. P3. K1.

11th row: K1. *P3. K3. Rep from *

to last 5 sts. P3. K2. **12th row:** As 2nd row.

Rep 1st to 12th rows for pattern (pat) until work from beginning (beg) measures approx 60" [152.5 cm], ending on 1st or 7th row.

Cast off in pat.
