

BERNAT GEOMETRIC KNIT BLANKET



MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Coal (10040) 4 balls

Contrast B Vintage White (10006) 3 balls

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.





KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

K = Knit

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 55" x 66" [139.5 x 167.5 cm].

GAUGE

 $7\frac{1}{2}$ sts and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Blanket is worked in 5 Strips that are sewn together.
- To change colors, twist the 2 colors around each other where they meet, on WS, to avoid a hole.

Strip (make 5)

With A, cast on 25 sts.

Knit 7 rows, noting 1st row is WS. **Next row: (RS). With A, K20.

With B, K5.

Next row: With B, K5. With A, K20. Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

Next row: (RS). With A, K15. With B, K10.

Next row: With B, K10. With A, K15. Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

Next row: (RS). With A, K10. With B, K15.

Next row: With B, K15. With A, K10. Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

Next row: (RS). With A, K5. With B, K20.

Next row: With B, K20. With A, K5. Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.***

With B, knit 8 rows. With A, knit 8 rows.** Rep from ** to **4 times more, then from ** to *** once.

With B, knit 7 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS)

Sew 5 Strips tog using flat seam, taking care to match pattern.
