

BERNAT KNIT NET BLANKET



MATERIALS

Bernat® Velvet™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Quail (32053)

5 balls

Size U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long or size **needed to obtain gauge.** 5" [12.5 cm] wide piece of cardboard for tassels.





KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue

K = Knit

Pat = Pattern

Psso = Pass slipped stitch over

Rep = Repeat **RS** = Right side

Sl1Kwyib = Skip next stitch

knitwise with yarn in back of work

St(s) = Stitch(es)

 $\mathbf{Yo} = \mathbf{Yarn} \ \mathbf{over}$

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 59" [127 x 152.5 cm], excluding tassels.

GAUGE

14 sts and 17 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Pat worked over multiple of 3 sts.

Cast on 174 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). K2. *yo. Sl1Kwyib. K2. Psso both knitted sts. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: K1. *SI1Kwyib. K2. Psso both knitted sts. yo. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

4th row: Purl.

These 4 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 59" [150 cm], ending on a 4th row. Cast off.

FINISHING

Loopy Tassels (make 30): Wind yarn around a piece of cardboard 5" [12.5 cm] wide 15 times. Tie through loops securely at 1 end. Wrap yarn 3 times around Tassel 1" [2.5 cm] down from tied end. Fasten securely. **Do not** cut loops at bottom of tassels. Sew 15 Tassels evenly spaced along each edge.
