Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle 36 " $[91.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ cable needle. 4 " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] wide piece of cardboard for tassels.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 60" [127 x 152.5 cm ], excluding tassels.

## GAUGE

13 sts and 17 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st

## INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 153 sts. Do not join. Work back and forth across needle in rows in garter st (knit every row), until work from beg measures $2 "[5 \mathrm{~cm}]$, noting 1st row is WS and ending on a WS row.
Next row: (RS). K9. *M1. K12. Rep from * to end of row. 165 sts.
Next row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
Proceed in Texture Pat 1 as follows (multiple of 10 sts + 15):
1st row: (RS). K7. *P1. K9. Rep from * to last 8 sts. P1. K7.

2nd row: K7. P1. *K1. P7. K1. P1. Rep from * to last 7 sts. K7.
3rd row: K7. *P1.K1.P1.K5. P1.K1. Rep from * to last 8 sts. P1. K7.
4th row: K7. P1. *K1. P1. K1. P3. (K1. P1) twice. Rep from * to last 7 sts. K7.
5th row: K7. *K2. (P1. K1) 4 times. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.

6th row: K7. P1. *P2. (K1. P1) 3 times. P2. Rep from * to last 7 sts. K7.
7th row: K7. *K4. P1. K1. P1. K3. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
8th row: K7. P1. *P4. K1. P5. Rep from * to last 7 sts. K7.
9th row: K7. *MB. K9. Rep from * to last 8 sts. MB. K7.
10th row: As 8th row.

11th row: As 7th row. 12th row: As 6th row. 13th row: As 5th row. 14th row: As 4th row. 15th row: As 3rd row. 16th row: As 2nd row. 17th row: As 1st row. 18th row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7 These 18 rows form Texture Pat 1 and 7-st garter st borders on each side.

Dividing Border A: 1 st row: (RS).
K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
2nd and 3rd rows: Knit.
4th and 5th rows: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
6th row: Knit.
7th row: K7. *SI1P. Tuck st. Slip last 2 sts back onto left-hand needle. K2tog (slipped st and tuck st). K9. Rep from * to last 8 sts. SI1P. Tuck st. Slip 2 sts just made back onto left-hand needle. K2tog (slipped st and tuck st). K7.
8th row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7. These 8 rows form Dividing Border A.


Next row: (RS). K13. *M1. K14. Rep from * to last 12 sts. M1. K12. 176 sts.
Next row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.

Proceed in Texture Pat 2 as follows (multiple of 10 sts + 36):
1 st row: (RS). K9. *K8. C2F. Rep from * to last 17 sts. K17.
2nd and alt rows: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
3rd row: K16. C2B. *C2F. K6. C2B. Rep from * to last 18 sts. C2F. K16. 5th row: K15. C2B. K1. *K1. C2F. K4. C2B. K1. Rep from * to last 18 sts. K1. C2F. K15
7th row: K14. C2B. K1. *C2F. K1. C2F. K2. C2B. K1. Rep from * to last 19 sts. C2F. K1. C2F. K14.
9th row: K13. C2B. K1. C2B. ${ }^{*}$ C2F. K1. C2F. C2B. K1. C2B. Rep from * to last 18 sts. C2F. K1. C2F. K13.
11th row: K12. (C2B. K1) twice. *(K1. C2F) twice. K1. C2B. K1. Rep from * to last 18 sts. *(K1. C2F) twice. K12.
13th row: As 7th row.
15th row: As 9th row.
17th row: As 11th row.
19th row: K14. C2B. K2. *K2. C2F. K2. C2B. K2. Rep from * to last 18 sts. K2. C2F. K14.
21 st row: K13. C2B. K3. *K3. C2F. C2B. K3. Rep from * to last 18 sts. K3. C2F. K13.

23rd row: K12. C2B. K4. *K4. C2F. K4. Rep from * to last 18 sts. *K4. C2F. K12.
24th row: As 2nd row.
These 24 rows form Texture Pat 2 and 7 -st garter st borders on each side.

Next row: (RS). K13. *K2tog. K13. Rep from * to last 13 sts. K2tog. K11. 165 sts.
Next row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.


Proceed in Texture Pat 3 as follows (multiple of 10 sts + 15):
1st row: (RS). K7. *K5. MB. K4. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
2nd and alt rows: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
3rd row: K7. *K4. MB. K1. MB. K3. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
5th row: K7. *(K3. MB) twice. K2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
7th row: K7. *K2. MB. K5. MB. K1. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
9th row: As 5th row.
11th row: As 3rd row.
13th row: As 1st row.
14th row: As 2nd row.
These 14 rows form Texture Pat 3 and 7-st garter st borders on each side.

Next row: (RS). Knit.
Next row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
Dividing Border C: 1st row: (RS). K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
2nd and 3rd rows: Knit.
4th and 5th rows: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
6th row: Knit.
These 6 rows form Dividing Border C.


Next row: (RS). K15. *M1. K15. Rep from * to end of row. 175 sts.
Next row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7.
Proceed in Texture Pat 4 as follows: 1st row: (RS). K7. *K5. P2. K3. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
2nd and alt rows to 12th row: K7. Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear to last 7 sts. K7.
3rd row: K7. *K4. P4. K2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.

5th row: K7. *K4. C4F. K2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.

7th row: K7. *K2. T4B. T4F. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
9th row: As 3rd row.

11th row: K7. *K2. C4F. C4B. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8. 13th row: As 5th row.
14th row: K7. P1. *P2. K4. P4. Rep from * to last 7 sts. K7.
15th row: As 3rd row.
16th row: K7. P1. *P3. K2. P5. Rep from * to last 7 sts. K7.
17th row: As 1st row.
18th row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7. These 18 rows form Texture Pat 4 and 7 -st garter st borders on each side.

Next row: (RS). K15. *K2tog. K14. Rep from * to end of row. 165 sts.
Next row: K7. Purl to last 7 sts. K7. Textured pats, Dividing Borders and side garter borders form pat.

Keeping cont of pat, work 8 rows of Dividing Border A. (multiple of 10 sts + 15):
1st row: (RS). K7. *K5. P1. K4. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
2nd and alt rows: K7. Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear to last 7 sts. K7.

Proceed in Texture Pat 5 as follows
3rd row: K7. *K4. P1. K1. P1. K3. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
5th row: K7. *K3. (P1. K1) 3 times. K1. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
7th row: K7. *K2. (P1. K1) 4 times. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
9th row: As 5th row.
11th row: As 3rd row.
13th row: As 1st row.
14th row: As 2nd row.
These 14 rows form Texture Pat 5 and 7-st garter st borders on each side.

Texture Pat 5


Keeping cont of pat, work 8 rows of Dividing Border B.

Proceed in Texture Pat 6 as follows: 1 st row: (RS). K7. *MB. K9. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
2nd and alt rows: K7. Purl to. Last 7 sts. K7.
3rd row: K7. *MB. K1. MB. K7. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
5th row: K7. *(MB. K1) 3 times. K4. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
7th row: K7. *(MB. K1) 4 times. K2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
9th row: K7. *K2. (MB. K1) 4 times. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
11th row: K7. *K4. (MB. K1) 3 times. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.
13th row: K7. *K6. (MB. K1) twice. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.


15th row: K7. *K8. MB. K1. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8. 16th row: As 2nd row.
These 16 rows form Texture Pat 6 and 7 -st garter st borders on each side.

Start Here
10-st rep

Work 6 rows of Dividing Border C. Work 14 rows of Texture Pat 5.
Work 8 rows of Dividing Border A.
Next row: (RS). K15. *M1. K15.
Rep from * to end of row. 175 sts.
Next row: Purl.

Work 18 rows of Texture Pat 4.

Next row: (RS). K15. *K2tog. K14. Top picot edging: 1st row: (WS). Rep from * to end of row. 165 sts. Next row: Purl.

Work 12 rows of Dividing Border B. Work 14 rows of Texture Pat 3.
Work 6 rows of Dividing Border C.
Next row: (RS). K13. *M1. K14 Rep from * to last 12 sts. M1. K12. 176 sts.
Next row: Purl.
Work 24 rows of Texture Pat 2.
Next row: (RS). K13. *K2tog. K13. Rep from * to last 13 sts. K2tog. K11. 165 sts.
Next row: Purl.
Work 8 rows of Dividing Border A. Work 18 rows of Texture Pat 1.

Next row: (RS). K9. *K2tog. K11. Rep from * to end of row. 153 sts. Work in garter st (knit every row) for 2" [ 5 cm ], ending on a RS row.

Cast off 1 st. *Cast on 5 sts. Cast off 15 sts. Rep from * to last 2 sts. Cast on 5 sts. Cast off 7 sts. Fasten off.

Bottom picot edging: With RS facing, pick up and knit 153 sts evenly across bottom edge of Blanket.
1st row: (WS). Cast off 1 st. *Cast on 5 sts. Cast off 15 sts . Rep from * to last 2 sts. Cast on 5 sts. Cast off 7 sts. Fasten off.

Tassels: Wrap yarn around 4" $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] piece of cardboard 10 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap yarn 6 times around tassel $11 / 2$ " $[4 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from tied end and fasten securely. Attach Tassels at ends of picots across top and bottom edges of Blanket.
