

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Freesia ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ (7.9 oz/225 g; $309 \mathrm{yds} / 282 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Indigo (24007) 3 balls
Contrast B Frosted Pine (24006) 2 balls
Contrast C Olive (24005) 3 balls
Size U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) circular knitting needle 29 " [ 73.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Begin(ning)
Cont $=$ Continue
Pat = Pattern
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat
K = Knit
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 61" [127 cm x 155 cm ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

12 sts and 17 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.
16 sts and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Pillar St.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 150 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Work in garter st (knit every row) for 2" [ 5 cm ] noting 1st row is WS and ending on a WS row.
Next row: (RS). *Kfb. K2. Rep from

* to end of row. 200 sts.
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch
RS = Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yo = Yarn over

1st row: (WS). K6. Purl to last 6 sts. K6.
2nd row: (RS). K6. *yo. K2. Pass yo over last 2 sts. Rep from * to last 6 sts. K6.
These 2 rows form Pillar St.
Cont in Pillar St with A until work from beg measures 21" [ 53.5 cm ], ending on a WS row. Break A.

With B, cont in Pillar St until work from beg measures 40 " [ 101.5 cm ], ending on a WS row. Break B.

With C, cont in Pillar St until work from beg measures 59" [150 cm], ending on a RS row.

## Yarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

Next row: (WS). With C, *K2tog. K2. 1 Fringe Knot and 1 group of Rep from * to end of row. 150 sts. With C, proceed in garter st (knit every row) until work from beg measures 61" [155 cm], ending on a RS row.
Cast off.
Knotted Fringe (see diagrams): Cut strands of A 30 " 776 cm ] long Taking 4 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe every 2 " 5 cm ] across top and bottom edge of Blanket, matching colors. Each Fringe knot has 8 strands.

Optional: Steam fringe lightly with steam iron or hand-held steamer (keeping iron or steamer several inches away from yarn) and comb out with fingers to straighten strands.

1st Knotted Row: Divide each fringe section into 2 groups of 4 strands. Skip first group of 4 strands. Taking next group of 4 strands from first Fringe Knot and first group of 4 strands from next Fringe Knot, tie into overhand knot 2" [ 5 cm ] down from each Fringe Knot. Cont across in this manner, taking 1 group of 4 strands from

4 strands from next Fringe Knot and tying tog in overhand knot. Leave rem group of 4 strands unworked. 2nd Knotted Row: Divide each newly knotted section into 2 groups of 4 strands. Taking first group of 4 strands (skipped group of 4 from 1st Knotted Row) and next group of 4 strands from next knot, tie in overhand knot 2" [5 cm ] down from 1st Knotted Row. Cont across in this manner, taking 1 group of 4 strands from 1 Knot and 1 group of 4 strands from next Knot and tying tog in overhand knot.
Trim fringe evenly.
