



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Cont = Continue(ity)

Pat = Pattern

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (Approx) 36" [91.5 cm] x 40" [101.5 cm].

GAUGE

7 stitches (sts) and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch (st).

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Blanket is made in 3 Panels worked from side to side and seamed together in Finishing (see diagram on page 2).
- Panels begin with 1st row as Right Side (RS). It may be helpful to place markers on Panel to indicate RS of work.

SIDE PANELS (make 2)

Stripe Pattern 1

*With A, work 8 rows garter stitch (st). Break A. Join B.

With B, work 8 rows garter st. Break B. Join C.

With C, work 8 rows garter st. Break C. Join D.

With D, work 8 rows garter st. Break D. Join E.

With E, work 8 rows garter st. Break E. Join C.

With C, work 8 rows garter st. Break C. Join A.*

Repeat (Rep) from * to * twice more.

These 144 rows form Stripe Pat 1.

With A, cast on 25 sts.

Keeping continuity (cont) of Stripe Pat 1, work in garter st (knit every row) until 144 rows of Stripe Pat 1 is complete.

Cast off.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Baby Sand (04010) **1 ball or 81 yds/74 m**

Contrast B Shell Pink (04758) **1 ball or 81 yds/74 m**

Contrast C Vanilla (04008) **1 ball or 162 yds/148 m**

Contrast D Mountain Mist (04826) **1 ball or 81 yds/74 m**

Contrast E Misty Jungle Green (04801) **1 ball or 81 yds/74 m**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Stitch markers. Yarn needle.

CENTER PANEL (make 1)

Stripe Pattern 2

**With C, work 8 rows garter st. Break C. Join A.
 With A, work 8 rows garter st. Break A. Join B.
 With B, work 8 rows garter st. Break B. Join C.
 With C, work 8 rows garter st. Break C. Join D.
 With D, work 8 rows garter st. Break D. Join E.
 With E, work 8 rows garter st. Break E. Join C.**
 Rep from ** to ** twice more.
 These 144 rows form Stripe Pat 2.

With C, cast on 20 sts.
 Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 2, work in garter st until 144 rows of Stripe Pat 2 is complete.
 Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew Panels together (tog) with C using mattress stitch as shown in diagram, aligning stripes and noting that RS of all Panels are facing and cast on edges are all aligned.
