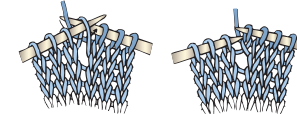
KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Dec = Decrease
Dip stitch = Insert right-hand needle into center of next stitch 3 rows below and draw up loose loop. Slip loop onto left-hand needle (counts as stitch).
Inc = Increase
K = Knit

K1tbl = Knit next stitch through back loop
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together
K2togtbl = Knit next 2 stitches together through back loops
M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop

Pat = Pattern
P = Purl
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Sl1(3)Pwyib = Slip next 1 (3) stitch(es) purlwise with yarn in back of work
Sl1Pwyif = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front of work
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side



MEASUREMENTS

Approx 40" x 42½" [101.5 x 108 cm].

GAUGE

8 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Each row is worked with 1 color only.
- Carry yarn when not in use loosely up side of work, taking new color from behind previous color, being careful not to twist strands, when changing yarns at beg of row.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket™ (10.6 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Main Color (MC) Black Bear (04828) **2 balls or 368 yds/337 m**

Bernat® Baby Blanket Sparkle™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Sunshine Sparkle (71003) **1 ball or 111 yds/101 m**

Contrast B Moonlight Sparkle (71001) **1 ball or 57 yds/52 m**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

- When slipping sts, hold yarn in back of work on RS and in front of work on WS.
- When carrying yarn behind/in front of slipped sts, be sure yarn is loose enough to maintain gauge and prevent work from puckering.

Mosaic Pat

1st row: (RS). With Color 2, K5. *Sl3Pwyib. K1. Dip st. K2togtbl (st just under Dip st and next st). Rep from * to last 8 sts. Sl3Pwyib. K5.

2nd row: K4. P2. *Sl1Pwyif. P5. Rep from * to last 7 sts. Sl1Pwyif. P2. K4.

3rd row: With MC, K8. *Sl3Pwyib. K3. Rep from * to last 5 sts. K5.

4th row: K4. P5. *Sl1Pwyif. P5. Rep from * to last 4 sts. K4.

5th row: K9. *Sl1Pwyib. K5. Rep from * to last 4 sts. K4.

6th row: K4. Purl to last 4 sts. K4.

7th row: With Color 2, K6. *Dip st. K2togtbl (st just under Dip st and next st). Sl3Pwyib. K1. Rep from * to last 7 sts. Dip st. K2togtbl (st just under Dip st and next st). K5.

8th row: K4. P5. *Sl1Pwyif. P5. Rep from * to last 4 sts. K4.

9th row: With MC, K5. *Sl3Pwyib. K3. Rep from * to last 8 sts. Sl3Pwyib. K5.

10th row: K4. P2. *Sl1Pwyif. P5. Rep from * to last 7 sts. Sl1Pwyif. P2. K4.

11th row: K6. *Sl1Pwyib. K5. Rep from * to last 7 sts. Sl1Pwyib. K6.

12th row: K4. Purl to last 4 sts. K4. These 12 rows form Mosaic Pat.

BLANKET

With MC, cast on 70 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 6 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Inc row: (WS). K4. M1. K7. (M1. K8) 6 times. M1. K7. M1. K4. 79 sts (multiple of 6 sts + 13).

Next row: Knit.

Next row: K4. Purl to last 4 sts. K4. Rep last 2 rows once more.

**Using A as Color 2, work 12 rows of Mosaic Pat, then rep 1st to 6th rows once more. Break A.

Using B as Color 2, work 7th to 12th rows of Mosaic Pat, then rep 12 rows Mosaic Pat once more. Break B.**

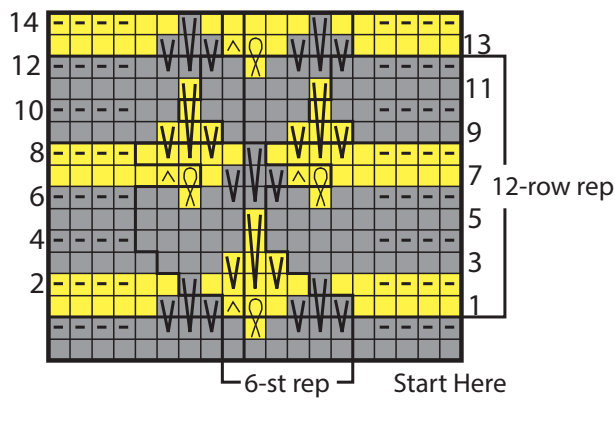
Rep from ** to ** twice more.

Using A as Color 2, work 12 rows of Mosaic Pat, then rep 1st to 4th rows once more. Break A.

Next row: (RS). With MC, knit.

Dec row: (WS). K4. K2tog. K6. (K2tog. K7) 6 times. K2tog. K6. K2tog. K3. 70 sts.

With MC, knit 5 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS).
