Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket $^{\text {Tm }} \mathbf{O}^{\mathbf{\prime} \mathbf{G o}^{\text {TM }}}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Agave (42010)
5 O'Gos


Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) circular knitting needle 29" [ 73.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt $=$ Alternate
Approx = Approximately
Beg = Begin(ning)
K = Knit
K2tog $=$ Knit next 2 stitches together
Prev = Previous
Psso = Pass slipped st over

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 58" [147 cm] wide x 62" [157.5 cm ] at longest point.

## GAUGES

7 sts and 14 rows $=4$ " [10 cm in garter st.
Each shell measures approx 18 " $[45.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ at widest point and 10 " [25.5 cm] tall.
$\mathbf{R S}=$ Right side
SI1 = Slip next stitch knitwise Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches one at a time. Pass them back onto lefthand needle, then knit through the back loops together.
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS $=$ Wrong side

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.


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- Use separated colors from O'Go (Contrast A, B, C) as indicated in Materials section.
- Blanket is worked by picking up sts from previous row and building upon it.
- When picking up sts, be sure to pick them up loosely to prevent puckering.


## SECTION 1

See diagram on page 3.
Beg Shell: With C, cast on 40 sts.
**1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1. 38 sts.
Rep last 2 rows to 4 sts.
Next row: K2tog. ssk.
Next row: SI1. K1. psso. Fasten off.**

## SECTION 2

1 st Shell: (RS). With B, pick up and knit 20 sts ( 1 st per garter st 'bump') down left side edge of Beg Shell. Using cable cast-on method here and throughout, cast on 20 sts. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ${ }^{* *}$ as given for Beg Shell.

2nd Shell: (RS). With B, cast on 20 sts. Pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of Shell from prev Section, from bottom to top. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

## SECTION 3

1st Shell: (RS). With A, pick up and knit 20 sts ( 1 st in each garter st 'bump') down left side edge of 1st Shell of prev Section. Cast on 20 sts. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

2nd Shell: (RS). With A, pick up and knit 20 sts down left side edge of 2nd Shell of prev Section. Pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of 1 st Shell of prev Section. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

3rd Shell: (RS). With A, cast on 20 sts. Pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of 2 nd Shell from prev Section. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

## SECTION 4

1st Shell: (RS). With C, pick up and knit 20 sts ( 1 st per garter st 'bump') down left side edge of 1 st Shell from prev Section. 20 sts.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 19 sts.
Rep last 2 rows to 2 sts.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.
2nd Shell: With C, work as given for 2nd Shell of Section 3.

3rd Shell: (RS). With C, pick up and knit 20 sts down left side edge of 3rd Shell of prev Section. Pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of 2 nd Shell of prev Section. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

4th Shell: (RS). With C, pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of 3rd Shell of prev Section.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.
Rep last 2 rows to 2 sts.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off. SECTION 5
1st Shell: With B, Work as given for 2nd Shell of Section 4.
2nd Shell: With B, work as given for 3rd Shell of Section 4.

3rd Shell: (RS). With B, pick up and knit 20 sts down left side edge of 4th Shell of prev Section. Pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of 3 rd Shell of prev Section. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

With A, work as given for Section 4.

## SECTION 7

With C, work as given for Section 5.

## SECTION 8

With B, work as given for Section 4.

## SECTION 9

With A, work as given for Section 5.

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## SECTION 10

1st Shell: (RS). With C, pick up and knit 20 sts down left side edge of 2nd Shell of prev Section. Pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of 1 st Shell of prev Section. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

2nd Shell: (RS). With C, pick up and knit 20 sts down left side edge of 3rd Shell of prev Section. Pick up and knit 20 sts up right side edge of 2 nd Shell of prev Section. 40 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Beg Shell.

## SECTION 11

Last Shell: With B, work as given for 1st Shell of Section 10.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Pin to measurements on a flat surface. Cover with damp cloths, leaving cloths to dry.
