

BERNAT SIMPLE CHEVRON KNIT BABY BLANKET

MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Lemon Lime (04223)
Contrast B Confetti (04868)

2 balls or 275 yds/251 m 1 ball or 215 yds/196.5 m

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue(ity)

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together.

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 38" [96.5 cm] wide x 40" [101.5 cm] long.

GAUGE

7 sts and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A, work 12 rows. With B, work 12 rows. These 24 rows form Stripe Pat.

BLANKET

With A, cast on 66 sts (multiple of 16 sts + 2). **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Set up row: (WS). Knit.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). K2. *ssk. K4. yo. K2. yo. K4. K2tog. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: Knit.

These 2 rows form Chevron Pat. First 3 rows of Stripe Pat are now in position.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cont in Chevron Pat until work from beg measures approx 40" [101.5 cm], ending on a 12th or 24th row of Stripe Pat.

Cast off knitwise (WS).
