Bernat $^{\oplus}$ Blanket $^{\text {TM }} \mathbf{O}^{\mathbf{\prime} \mathbf{G o}^{\text {TM }}}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )

Turquoise (42053)
Sunshine (42061)
Foxglove (42052)
Violet (42054)


Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. Piece of cardboard 7" [18 cm ] wide for tassels.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $50 \times 60$ " $127 \times 152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] excluding tassels.

## GAUGE

8 sts and 16 rows $=4$ " 10 cm ] in garter stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Working with O'Go:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section for O'Go (Contrast A to L). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label the bags - A to L.

## Stripe Pat 1

Work 22 rows each in the following sequence: L, D, F, A, J, H, B.

## Stripe Pat 2

Work 22 rows each in the following sequence: G, E, K, B, I, C, L.

## Stripe Pat 3

Work 22 rows each in the following sequence: I, L, J, H, A, F, D.

## Stripe Pat 4

Work 22 rows each in the following sequence: K, B, G, C, E, I, J.

RECTANGLE 1: Make 1 each in Stripe Pat 1 and 3.

Note: Work Kfb increases loosely to prevent edges from puckering.
**Cast on 1 st
1 st row: (RS). (K1. yo. K1) all in same st. 3 sts.

## 2nd and alt rows: Knit

3rd row: (Kfb) twice. K1. 5 sts.
5th row: (K1. Kfb) twice. K1. 7 sts. 7th row: K1. Kfb. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. - 2 sts inc'd.
8th row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until there are 45 sts, ending on a WS row (last row of 3rd stripe in Stripe Pat).**

Cont in Stripe Pat, work even as follows:
1st row: (RS). K1. K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 45 sts.
2nd row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 10 times more (ending with last row of 4th stripe in Stripe Pat).
***Cont in Stripe Pat, dec as follows:
1st row: (RS). K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.
2nd row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows until there are 5 sts
Next row: K1. K3tog. K1.
Next row: K3tog.
Fasten off.***
RECTANGLE 2: Make 1 each in Stripe Pat 2 and 4.

Work from ** to ** as given for Rectangle 1.

Cont in Stripe Pat, work even as follows:
1st row: (RS). Kfb. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.
2nd row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 10 times more (ending with last row of 4th stripe in Stripe Pat).

Work from *** to *** as given for Rectangle 1.

## FINISHING

Sew 4 Rectangles tog as seen in Assembly Diagram using a flat seam taking care to match stripes.

## Tassels

Make 1 each in L, D, C and I.
Cut a piece of cardboard 7 " $[18 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] wide. Wind yarn around cardboard 60 times, Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 2" [ 5 cm ] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Sew 1 Tassel to each corner of Blanket.
