MATERIALS

Bernat[®] Blanket Extra[™] (10.5 oz/300 g; 97 yds/87 m)

Silver Steel (27039)

6 balls or 575 yds/520 m

Size U.S. 19 (15 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or** size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
K = Knit
P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches
together
Pat = Pattern
Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise
one at a time. Pass them back
onto left-hand needle, then knit
through back loops together
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS Approx 47" x 54" [119 x 137 cm].

GAUGE

7.5 sts and 6.5 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Herringbone St Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 88 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle, knit 1 row.

Proceed in pat as follows: **1st row:** K1. *ssk, but **do not** drop off left-hand needle. K1 in same first st. Slip both sts off left-hand needle. Rep from * to last st. K1. **2nd row:** *P2tog and leave sts on left-hand needle. Purl first st again. Slip both sts off left-hand needle. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for Herringbone St Pat until work from beg measures 54" [137 cm], ending on a RS row. Cast off knitwise (WS).
