MATERIALS

Bernat® Forever Fleece™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 194 yds/177 m)

Main Color (MC) White Noise (61004) **3 balls**

Contrast A Rolling Sky (61043) **2 balls**

Contrast B Seaglass (61049) **2 balls**

Size U.S. 13 [9 mm] Susan Bates® circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® stitch markers. Susan Bates® yarn needle. 6" [15 cm] wide piece of cardboard for tassels.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue(ity)

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

Pat = Pattern

Pssso = Pass slipped stitch over

Rep = Repeat

Rnd = Round

RS = Right side

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 55" [127 x 152.5 cm]

GAUGE

10 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Chevron Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Chevron Pat worked over multiple of 14 sts + 6. Place marker after every rep for easier counting. **Do not** carry color at side of work. Break previous color and join new color.

Stripe Pat

With MC – 16 rows.

With A – 20 rows.

With MC – 10 rows.

With B – 20 rows.

With MC – 20 rows.

With B – 20 rows.

With MC – 10 rows.

With A – 20 rows.

With MC – 16 rows.

These 152 rows complete Stripe Pat.

BLANKET

With MC, cast on 129 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, knit 4 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Next row: (WS). K10. *Kfb. K6. Rep from * to end of row. 146 sts.

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). With A, K3. Kfb. *K4. ssk. K2tog. K4. (Kfb) twice. Rep from * to last 16 sts. K4. ssk. K2tog. K4. Kfb. K3.

2nd row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last 2 rows for Chevron Pat until all 152 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Break A and B.

Next row: (RS). K10. *K2tog. K6. Rep from * to end of row. 129 sts. Knit 4 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).

Tassels (make 21)

Cut a piece of cardboard 6" [15 cm] wide. Wind B around cardboard 10 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 1" [2.5 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Tie Tassels to top and bottom edges of Blanket, attaching one Tassel to each "peak" along the edges as pictured.
