#### **MATERIALS**

Bernat® Blanket Perfect Phasing™ (10.5 oz/300 q; 220 yds/201 m)

Deep Black (43001)

4 balls

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) Susan Bates Silvalume circular knitting needle 36" (91.5 cm) long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® yarn needle.





#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Approx = **K2tog** = Knit next St(s) = Stitch(es)2 stitches together **Approximately Yo** = Yarn over

**Beg** = Beginning **Pat** = Pattern  $\mathbf{K} = Knit$ **Rep** = Repeat

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 45" x 65" [114.5 x 165 cm]

# **GAUGE**

9 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Eyelet Pat.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

### Notes:

- Beg working from darkest end of yarn at bottom edge of Blanket.
- To maintain ombre effect join next ball from opposite end so shades match (lightest end to lightest end or darkest end to darkest end) as necessary, resulting in a fade from dark-tolight to light-to-dark, and back again across the Blanket.
- · Blanket should start and end with darkest shade.
- Blanket is reversible. There is no right or wrong side.

### **BLANKET**

Cast on 102 stitches (sts) (multiple of 3 sts). **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: \*Knit 1 (K1). Yarn over (yo). Knit next 2 stitches together (K2tog). Repeat (Rep) from \* to end of row.

Rep last row for Easy Eyelet Pat until Blanket measures 65" [152.5 cm].

Cast off.
