

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Forever Fleece ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $9.9 \mathrm{oz} / 280 \mathrm{~g} ; 194 \mathrm{yds} / 177 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Balsam Tweed (61014) $\mathbf{3}$ balls or 570/515 yds/m
Contrast B Rose Hip Tweed (61003) $\mathbf{3}$ balls or 580/530 yds/m
Contrast C White Noise Tweed (61004) $\mathbf{3}$ balls or 520/470 yds/m
Size U.S. 13 ( 9 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle $36 "\left[91.5 \mathrm{~cm}\right.$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ steel yarn needle. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ split-lock stitch count markers.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
K = Knit
K2tog $=$ Knit next 2 stitches together
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch $\mathbf{R e p}=$ Repeat

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 60" [127 x 152.5 cm ].

## GAUGE

10 sts and 13 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With C, cast on 129 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, knit 6 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS. Next row: (WS). K10. *Kfb. K6. Rep from * to end of row. 146 sts.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows: (See Diagram on page 2)

RS = Right side
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

1st row: (RS). With A, K3. Kfb. *K4. ssk. K2tog. K4. (Kfb) twice. Rep from * to last 16 sts. K4. ssk. K2tog. K4. Kfb. K3.
2nd row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3.
3rd to 8th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows 3 times more.
9th and 10th rows: With B, as 1st and 2 nd rows.
11th row: With $B$, as 1 st row.
12th row: With B, knit.
13th to 16th rows: With $C$, as 1 st and 2 nd rows.
17th and 18th rows: With $A$, as 1st and 2nd rows.
19th row: With $A$, as 1 st row.
20th row: With A, knit.
21st to 28th rows: With $B$, as 1st and 2nd rows 4 times more.

29th and 30th rows: With C, as 1st and 2nd rows.
31 st row: With C, as 1st row.
32nd row: With C, knit.
33rd to 36th rows: With A, as 1st and 2nd rows twice more.
37th and 38th rows: With B, as 1st and 2nd rows.
39th row: With B, as 1st row.
40th row: With B, knit.
41st to 48th rows: With C, as 1st and 2 nd rows 4 times more.
49th and 50th rows: With A , as 1st and 2nd rows.
$\mathbf{5 1}$ st row: With $A$, as 1st row.
52nd row: With A, knit.
53rd to 56th rows: With B, as 1st and 2nd rows twice more.
57th and 58th rows: With C, as 1st and 2nd rows.
59th row: With C, as 1st row.
60th row: With C, knit.
These 60 rows form Stripe Pat.
Rep last 60 rows for Chevron Striped Pat twice more, then 1st to 12th rows once.

Next row: (RS). With C, K10. *K2tog. K6. Rep from * to end of row. 129 sts. Knit 4 rows (garter st).
Cast off knitwise (WS).
