



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1Pwyib = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in back of work.

Sl1Pwyif = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front of work.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 58" [127 x 147.5 cm], excluding fringe.

GAUGES

14 sts and 30 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

14 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Slip St Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Blanket is worked lengthwise.
- Carry color not in use loosely up side of work.
- Slip St Pat worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 11.

BLANKET

With MC, cast on 203 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 4 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is RS.

Proceed in Slip St Pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: K2. Purl to last 2 sts. K2.

3rd row: With A, K8. *Sl1Pwyib. K5. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

4th row: K3. *K5. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.

5th to 8th rows: With MC, as 1st and 2nd rows twice.

9th row: With A, K5. *Sl1Pwyib. K5. Rep from * to end of row.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Maker (8.8 oz/250 g; 317 yds/290 m)

Main Color (MC) Navy (6017) **6 balls or 1902 yds/1740 m**

Contrast A Cream (6003) **3 balls or 951 yds/870 m**

Size U.S. 10 1/2 (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® circular knitting needle [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) Susan Bates® crochet hook for fringe. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

10th row: K5. Sl1Pwyif. *K5. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * to last 5 sts. K5.
11th and 12 rows: With MC, as 1st and 2nd rows.
These 12 rows form Slip St Pat.

Cont in Slip St Pat until Blanket measures approx 49½" [125.5 cm], ending on a 1st or 7th row of pat.
Knit 4 rows (garter st).
Cast off.

FINISHING

Side Fringe: Cut lengths of A 10" [25.5 cm] long. Taking 4 strands of A tog, fold in half and knot into fringe with crochet hook between each set of A-rows (3rd/4th rows and 9th/10th rows). Trim fringe evenly.
