

#### **BERNAT LINEN STITCH KNIT PILLOW | KNIT**



#### **MATERIALS**

**Bernat**® **Blanket Ombre**™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Ocean Teal Ombre (36006) 2 balls or 401 yds/ 1017 m

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. 24" [61 cm] square pillow form.



KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Cont** = Continu(e)(ity)

K = Knit

**Pat** = Pattern

 $\mathbf{P} = \text{Purl}$ 

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side **St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Sl1wyib** = Slip next stitch

with yarn in back

**Sl1wyif** = Slip next stitch

with yarn in front

**WS** = Wrong side

## **MEASUREMENT**

Approx 24" [61 cm] square.

### **GAUGE**

8 sts and 13 rows in stocking st.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Front

Note: For striping effect shown, work with 2 balls throughout Front panel. Begin using each ball at different points in color gradation to ensure contrasting shades. In most cases, this is achieved by working from the exterior of first ball and from interior of second. If necessary to ensure color contrast, remove a single color from exterior of one ball then set this yarn aside to be used for seaming or back panels. Alternate between these two balls every 2 rows.

Cast on 60 sts.

1st row: (RS). \*K1. Sl1wyif. Rep

from \* across.

2nd row: \*P1. Sl1wyib. Rep from

\* across.

Keeping cont of striping effect (see note above), rep these 2 rows for Linen Stitch Pat until Front measures approx 24" [61 cm] from beg, ending on 2nd row. Cast off.



# BERNAT LINEN STITCH KNIT PILLOW | KNIT

Back (make 2 alike).

Cast on 48 sts.

1st row: (RS). K3. \*P2. K2. Rep

from \* to last st. K1.

2nd row: P3. \*K2. P2. Rep from

\* to last st. P1.

Rep these 2 rows until work from beg measures 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 15" [38 cm]. Cast off.

### **Finishing**

Overlap Back pieces to match Front, with ribbed sections in center to create opening to insert pillow form. Sew outer edge seams.
