



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =	K = Knit	St(s) = Stitch(es)
Approximately	P = Purl	WS = Wrong side
Beg = Beginning	Rep = Repeat	
Cont = Continue(ity)	RS = Right side	

MEASUREMENT

Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

GAUGE

10 sts and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Pillow is worked in one piece. Purl ridges on Front section create placement for vertical chain details worked during Finishing.

Lower Back: With MC, cast on 51 sts.

1st row: (WS). K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows of (K1. P1) ribbing 5 times more, then 1st row once.

Beg on a knit row, work in stocking st until work from beg measures 10" [25.5 cm], ending on a purl row.

Next row: With A, knit.

Next row: (WS-fold line). Knit. Break A.

Front: 1st row: (RS). With MC, K1. P1. (K7. P1) 6 times. K1.

2nd row: K2. (P7. K1) 6 times. K1.

3rd to 12th rows: Rep 1st and 2nd rows 5 times more.

13th row: With A, knit. Break A.

14th row: With MC, K2. (P7. K1) 6 times. K1.

15th row: K1. P1. (K7. P1) 6 times. K1.

16th to 25th rows: Rep 14th and 15th rows 5 times more.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Forever Fleece™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 194 yds/177 m)

Main Color (MC) Patchouli (61001) **2 balls**

Contrast A Walnut (61020) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 13 (9 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook for vertical chain details. 20" [51 cm] square pillow form. Yarn needle.

26th row: With A, purl. Break A.
Rep 1st to 26th rows twice more.
Next row: (RS-fold line). Purl.

Upper Back: Beg on a purl row, with MC, work in stocking st until work from last fold line measures 10" [25.5 cm], ending on a purl row.
Work 12 rows in (K1. P1) ribbing as given for Lower Back.
Cast off in rib.

FINISHING

Vertical Lines: Hold A on WS of work. Insert crochet hook from RS to WS just above fold line at base of column of purl sts and pull loop of yarn through. Keeping this loop on hook, insert hook through same column of purl sts 2 rows up and pull through next loop of yarn. Pull last loop through loop already on the hook. Cont in this manner ending at 2nd fold line. Fasten off.

Rep for each column of purl sts. Take care to keep your chain sts loose to prevent puckering.

Fold Pillow cover at fold lines, overlapping Lower and Upper Backs. Sew side seams, working through all layers in overlapped section. Insert pillow form.
