Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A 1 ball or
Ashen Titanium (10954)

## Contrast B

Malachite (10802)
32 yds/29.5 m per Pillow
1 ball or
185 yds/169 m per Pillow
OR
Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket Brights ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast B Bright Pink (12042) 1 ball or
or Bright Lime (12041) 185 yds/ 169 m per Pillow
Set of 4 size U.S. $10(6 \mathrm{~mm})$ Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ double-pointed knitting needles and size U.S. $10(6 \mathrm{~mm})$ circular knitting needle $29 "\left[73.5 \mathrm{~cm}\right.$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ split-lock stitch count markers. Fiberfill stuffing.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 123/4" [ 32.5 cm ], diameter excluding Top.

## GAUGE

9 sts and 15 rows $=4$ " 10 cm ] in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Bauble is knit in the rnd and stuffed before sts for Top are picked-up and knit around.
- l-cord Hanging Loop is knit separately and sewn into place.

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together
PM = Place marker
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS $=$ Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)

## BAUBLE

## Body

## Increase Section

With B, with set of 4 double-pointed needles, cast on 6 sts leaving a 12" [ 30.5 cm ] long yarn tail for closing base. Divide sts onto 3 needles ( 2 , 2, 2). Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.

Note: Change to circular needle when necessary.

1st rnd: Kfb in each st around. 12 sts.
2nd and alt rnds until 10th rnd: Knit.
3rd rnd: *K1. Kfb. Rep from * around. 18 sts.

5th rnd: *K2. Kfb. Rep from * Knit even in rnds until work from around. 24 sts.
7th rnd: *K3. Kfb. Rep from * around. 30 sts.
9th rnd: *K4. Kfb. Rep from * around. 36 sts.
11th rnd: *K5. Kfb. Rep from * around. 42 sts.
12th and 13th rnds: Knit.
14th rnd: *K6. Kfb. Rep from * around. 48 sts.
15th and 16th rnds: Knit.
17th rnd: *K7. Kfb. Rep from * around. 54 sts.
18th and 19th rnds: Knit.
20th rnd: *K8. Kfb. Rep from * around. 60 sts.
21st and 22nd rnds: Knit.
23rd rnd: *K9. Kfb. Rep from * around. 66 sts.
24th and 25th rnds: Knit.
26th rnd: *K10. Kfb. Rep from * around. 72 sts.
27th and 28th rnds: Knit.
29th rnd: *K11. Kfb. Rep from * around. 78 sts.
30th and 31st rnds: Knit.
32nd rnd: *K12. Kfb. Rep from * around. 84 sts.
33rd and 34th rnds: Knit.
35th rnd: *K13. Kfb. Rep from * around. 90 sts. PM at end of rnd.
marker measures $31 / 2^{"}[9 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## Decrease Section

Note: Change to double-pointed needles when necessary.
1st rnd: *K13. K2tog. Rep from * around. 84 sts.
2nd and 3rd rnds: Knit.
4th rnd: *K12. K2tog. Rep from * around. 78 sts.
5th and 6th rnds: Knit.
7th rnd: *K11. K2tog. Rep from * around. 72 sts.
8th and 9th rnds: Knit.
10th rnd: *K10. K2tog. Rep from * around. 66 sts.
11th and 12th rnds: Knit.
13th rnd: *K9. K2tog. Rep from * around. 60 sts.
14th and 15th rnds: Knit.
16th rnd: *K8. K2tog. Rep from * around. 54 sts.
17th and 18th rnds: Knit.
19th rnd: *K7. K2tog. Rep from * around. 48 sts.
20th and 21st rnds: Knit.
22nd rnd: *K6. K2tog. Rep from * around. 42 sts.
23rd and 24th rnds: Knit.
25th rnd: *K5. K2tog. Rep from * around. 36 sts. 26th rnd (ridge rnd): Purl.

27th rnd: *K4. K2tog. Rep from * around. 30 sts.

Stuff Bauble Body into a firm ball shape, being careful to avoid overstuffing and stretching sts.

28th and alt rnds: Knit.
29th rnd: *K3. K2tog. Rep from * around. 24 sts.
31st rnd: *K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 18 sts.
33rd rnd: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 12 sts.
35th rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 6 sts.
Break yarn leaving a 12" [30.5 cm ] long yarn tail. Draw tail tightly through rem sts and fasten securely.

With yarn needle, weave tail from cast-on tightly through 6 cast-on sts and tighten to close hole. Fasten securely.

## Top

With A and RS facing, pick-up and knit 36 sts evenly around 26th rnd (ridge rnd) of Decrease Section (picking up a st in each purl 'ridge'). Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.

Knit even in rnds until work from picked up sts measures $23 / 4$ " $[7 \mathrm{~cm}]$. Next rnd (ridge rnd): Purl.

## Decrease Top Section

1st rnd: *K4. K2tog. Rep from * around. 30 sts.

Stuff Top into firm flat-topped columnar shape, being careful to avoid overstuffing and stretching sts and noting that purl rnd should form edge at Top.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.
3rd rnd: *K3. K2tog. Rep from * around. 24 sts.
5th rnd: *K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 18 sts.
7th rnd: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 12 sts.
9th rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 6 sts.
Break yarn leaving a 12 " [30.5 cm ] long yarn tail. Draw tail tightly through rem sts and fasten securely.

## FINISHING

## I-Cord Hanging Loop

With A and 2 double-pointed needles, cast on 3 sts leaving a long tail.
Work cord as follows: *Slide sts to other end of needle without turning work. K3. Rep from * until cord measures 9 " [ 23 cm ]. Cast off leaving a long tail.

Using long tails and yarn needle, sew ends of Hanging Loop to Top of Bauble, attaching ends approx 1" [2.5 cm ] in from Edge (as shown in photo).
