## Notes:

- Text in bold refers to knots illustrated with diagrams.
- Do not tie knots tightly; doing so will alter finished measurements

Instructions for Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row: Last cord on right is "knotbearer". With next cord to left, tie Horizontal RightLeft Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working right-to-left, continue tying Horizontal RightLeft Double Half Hitch Knots to knot-bearer using next cord to left of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.


HORIZONTAL RIGHT-LEFT DOUBLE half Hitch

## Instructions for Left-Right

 Double Half Hitch Row: First cord on left is "knot-bearer". With next cord to right, tie Diagonal LeftRight Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working left-to-right, continue tying Diagonal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot to knot-bearer using next cord to right of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

DIAGONAL LEFT-RIGHT DOUBLE HALF HITCH

Instructions for Diagonal RightLeft Double Half Hitch Row: Last cord on right is "knot-bearer". With next cord to left, tie Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working right-to-left, continue tying Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot to knot-bearer using next cord to left of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.


DIAGONAL RIGHT-LEFT DOUBLE HALF HITCH

FRONT AND BACK (make alike)

1. Cut 14 cords 80 " [ 203 cm ] long.
2. Fold each cord in half and tie to purse handle using Lark's Head Knot.
3. Working from left-to-right with groups of 4 cords, tie Square Knots across all cords.
4. Skip first 2 cords. (Square Knot over next 4 cords) twice. Skip next 8 cords. (Square Knot over next 4 cords) twice. Leave last 2 cords unworked.
5. (Square Knot over next 4 cords) twice. Skip next 12 cords. (Square Knot over next 4 cords) twice.
6. With 14th cord from left as knot-bearer, work Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row with first 13 cords. With 15th cord as knot-bearer, work Diagonal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row with remaining cords.
7. Working from left-to-right with groups of 4 cords, tie Square Knots across all cords, ensuring knots are snug against previous Diagonal Double Half Hitch Rows.
8. Repeat Steps 6 and 7 once more.
9. With 14 th cord from left as knot-bearer, work Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row with first 13 cords. With 15th cord as knot-bearer, work Diagonal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row with remaining cords.

Note: For Steps 10 to 16, ensure knots are worked snug against Diagonal Double Half Hitch Rows.
10. Working from left-to-right, skip first 12 cords. Tie Square Knot over next 4 cords. Leave last 12 cords unworked.
11. Working from left-to-right, skip first 10 cords. Tie Square Knot over each of next 2 groups of 4 cords. Leave last 10 cords unworked.
12. Working from left-to-right, skip first 8 cords. Tie Square Knot over each of next 3 groups of 4 cords. Leave last 8 cords unworked.
13. Working from left-to-right, skip first 6 cords. Tie Square Knot over each of next 4 groups of 4 cords. Leave last 6 cords unworked.
14. Working from left-to-right, skip first 4 cords. Tie Square Knot over each of next 5 groups of 4 cords. Leave last 6 cords unworked.
15. Working from left-to-right, skip first 2 cords. Tie Square Knot over each of next 6 groups of 4 cords. Leave last 2 cords unworked.
16. Working from left-to-right with groups of 4 cords, tie Square Knots across all cords.
17. Holding right-most cord horizontally and in front of other cords, work Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row.
18. Cut 15 " $[38 \mathrm{~cm}]$ cord and unply full length.
19. Using one ply and yarn needle, sew Front and Back together, starting and ending $11 / 2$ " $[4 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from purse handle.
20. Trim ends to $5^{\prime \prime}$ [ 12.5 cm ].
21. Un-ply loose end of each cord by twisting cord clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot. Comb fringe and trim evenly.
