CRAFT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

INSTRUCTIONS

- Yarn consists of “paired” loops, one loop in color “A” and one loop in color “B”
- Only one loop from each paired loop is worked with at a time One side of project is worked in its entirety, then work is turn inside out complete op posite side.
- Project is reversible with shade placement reversed on opposite side
- Loops are always pulled through stitches from back to front of work.
- An unworked loop is referred to as a “loop”.
- A loop which has been worked is referred to as a “stitch”.

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

2-color chain: Cut first loop of yarn close to base to create a tail approximately 3” [7.5 cm] long. Count **48 (52)** paired loops from end of yarn (each paired loop contains one loop in color “A” and one loop in color “B”).

MATERIALS

Bernat® Alize® Blanket EZ Graph-it™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 15 yds/13.5 m)

Sizes	Child 6 to 12	Adult	
Navy/Blue Fog (71007)	1	1	ball

1 safety pin. Yarn needle.

SIZES

To fit **Child 6 to 12 (Adult)** head.

GAUGE

8 stitches = 4" [10 cm].

Tie tail to yarn between **48th and 49th (52nd and 53rd)** loops to create ring. Place ring on a flat surface with all "A" loops pointing outside and all "B" loops pointing inside of ring and working yarn (yarn feeding from ball) at right.

FIRST SIDE

To read Chart:

- Rounds are worked from **right to left**
- Each square of Chart represents one stitch
- Color of square represents which color of paired loop is to be used

1st round: Working from **right to left** and with "A" loops only, pull first loop from working yarn up through first loop of round (first loop to the left of tie) to create a knit stitch. Pull next loop from working yarn up through next loop of foundation round. Continue in this manner to end of round. Place safety pin between first and last stitches of round to mark end of round. **48 (52)** stitches in round. Leave all remaining unworked loops at back of work for Second Side.

2nd round: Working from **right to left**, pull first loop from working yarn up through first stitch of round. Pull next loop from working yarn up through next stitch of round. Continue in this manner to end of round.

First two rounds of chart are now complete.

Continue as established to 12th round of Chart, noting that 4-st rep is worked **12 (13)** times.

12th round: *Pull next "A" loop from working yarn up through next stitch of round. Pull next "B" loop from working yarn up through next stitch of round. Hold next loop on top of following loop creating a double loop – treat this double loop as 1 st. Pull next "B" loop up through double loop – decrease made. Repeat from * around. **36 (39)** stitches.

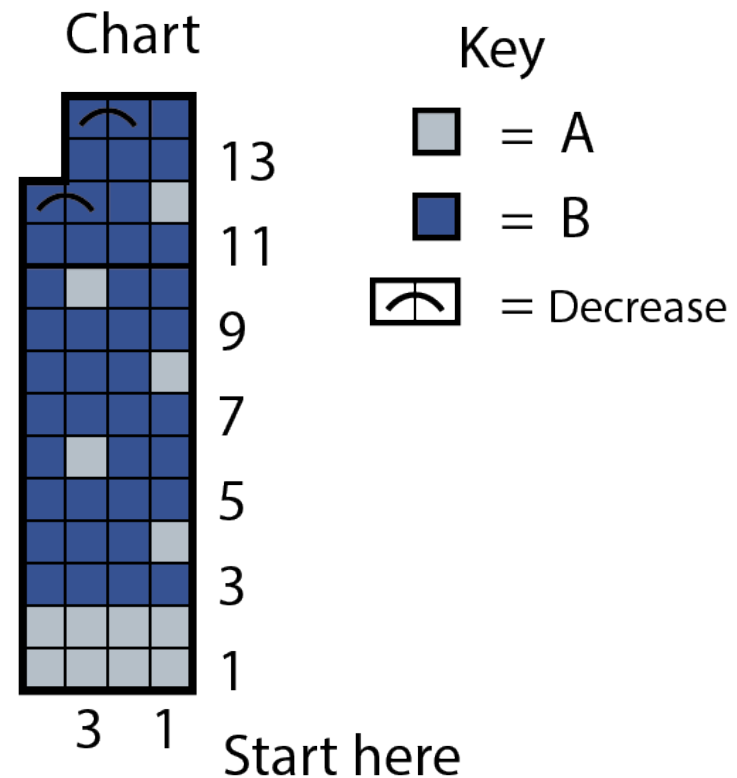
13th round: Pull next "B" loop from working yarn up through next stitch of round. Continue in this manner to end of round.

14th round: *Pull next "B" loop from working yarn up through next stitch of round. Work decrease in "B" over next 2 stitches. Repeat from * to end of round. **24 (26)** stitches.

15th round: As 13th round.

Bind off: Working in same direction as last round, pull 2nd stitch through 1st stitch. Pull 3rd stitch through 2nd stitch. Pull 4th stitch through 3rd stitch. Continue in this manner to end.

Cut working yarn approximately 6 loops past last stitch. Carefully cut thread at base of these loops to release the loop and create a smooth yarn 'tail'. With A, pull tail through last loop of Bind off row. Leave remaining tail unworked for second side.



SECOND SIDE

Notes:

- Second Side is worked from the bottom in rounds.
- Turn work inside-out.

1st to 11th rounds: Beginning at first stitch, of round, pull up remaining loop through last stitch. This creates first stitch of round. *Pull next loop up through next stitch. Repeat from * around.

12th round: *Work 1 decrease over next 2 stitches. (Pull next loop up through next stitch) twice. Repeat from * around. **36 (39)** stitches.

13th round: As 1st round.

14th round: *Work 1 decrease over next 2 stitches. Pull next loop up through next stitch. Repeat from * around. **24 (26)** stitches.

Bind off: Beginning at opposite side from yarn tails and with remaining loops, pull 2nd stitch through 1st stitch. Pull 3rd stitch through 2nd stitch. Pull 4th stitch through 3rd stitch.

Continue in this manner to end of round.

Cut working yarn approximately 6 loops past last stitch. Carefully cut thread at base of these loops to release the loop and create a smooth yarn 'tail'.

Tie "A" and "B" tails together close to work to secure. Clip each remaining loop at base to create a yarn tail. Thread tail through each bound off stitch, and cinch tightly to close crown of Hat. Weave in tails.
