

BERNAT® alize® EZ WOOL SEED STITCH SCARF | CRAFT



MATERIALS

Bernat® Alize® EZ Wool™ (5.3 oz/150 g; 11 yds/10 m)
Berry Compote (09013) **4 balls**



CRAFT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 10" x 74" [25.5 x 188 cm], excluding fringe.

GAUGE

5 stitches = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Right side of project is facing at all times
- Scarf is worked in Seed Stitch – alternating knit stitches and purl stitches
- For Knit stitches 'Working yarn' is held behind stitches
- For Purl stitches 'Working yarn' is held in front of stitches
- Scarf is reversible

Count 13 loops for foundation row (noting yarn end is at far right and all loops are facing upwards).

1st row: Working from **left to right**, with working yarn at back, pull 14th loop (from 'working yarn') up through 13th loop (last loop of foundation row) from

behind to create a knit stitch.
*With working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch to create a purl stitch. With working yarn at back, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch to create a knit stitch. Repeat from * to end of row. **Do not** turn. 13 stitches.

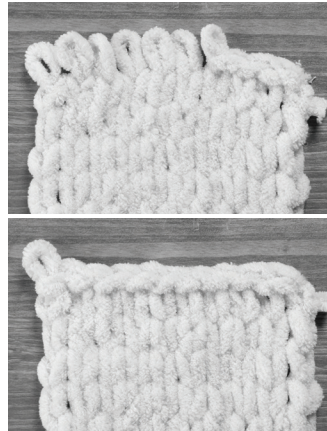
2nd row: Working from **right to left**, with working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn towards back through last stitch worked on previous row to create a purl stitch.

*With working yarn at back, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch to create knit stitch. With working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch to create a purl stitch. Repeat from * to end of row. **Do not** turn.

3rd row: Working from **left to right**, with working yarn at back, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through 1st stitch worked on previous row to create a knit stitch. *With working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch to create a purl stitch. With working yarn at back, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch to create a knit stitch. Repeat from * to end of row. **Do not** turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until work measures approximately 74" [188 cm].

Bind off row: Working in **same direction as last row**, pull 2nd stitch through first stitch. Pull 3rd stitch through 2nd stitch. Pull 4th stitch through 3rd stitch. Continue in this manner to end of row. Cut last loop to create yarn tail. Pull yarn tail through last loop. Tie to secure and weave in ends.



Fringe: Cut base of loops carefully to create a straight length of yarn approximately 180" [457 cm] long (will be cut to make fringe). Cut strands of yarn 16" [40.5 cm] long. Fold 1 strand in half and knot into fringe across both ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
