Beach (46006)	2 balls
Version 2	
Citrus (46004)	2 balls
Version 3	
Fairy (46008)	2 balls

CRAFT I SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

St(s) = Stitch(es)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 10" x 72" [25.5 x 183 cm], excluding fringe.

#### GAUGE

5 sts = 4" [10 cm].

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Notes:

- Right side of project is facing at all times
- When joining new ball, cut base of first and last loops to create ends for secure sts and take care to match stripe section.

#### SCARF

Count first 13 loops of any color for foundation row (noting yarn end is at far right and all loops are facing **1st row:** Working from **left** to **right**, with working yarn in back, pull 14th loop (from 'working yarn') up through 13th loop from behind to create a knit st. Pull next loop from working yarn up through next loop of foundation row to create next knit st. Continue in this manner to end of row. **Do not** turn work. 13 sts in row.

**2nd row:** Working from **right** to **left**, with working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn towards back through last st worked on previous row to create a purl st. \*Pull next loop from working yarn up through next st to create a knit st. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next st to create a purl st. Repeat from \* to end of row. **Do not** turn.

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
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3rd row: Working from left to *right*, with working yarn in back, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through last st worked on previous row. \*Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next st. Repeat from \* to end of row. **Do not** turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until Scarf from beginning measures approx 70" [178 cm], ending with 16 stripes as shown.



Bind off row: Working in same direction as last row, pull 2nd st through first st. Pull 3rd st through 2nd st. Pull 4th st through 3rd st. Continue in this manner to end of row. Cut last loop to create yarn tail. Pull yarn tail through last loop. Tie to secure and weave in ends.



Fringe: Cut base of loops to create a straight length of yarn of each color. Cut strands of yarn 16" [40.5 cm] long. Fold 2 strands in half and knot into fringe across both ends of Scarf alternating: Color 1, Color 2. Trim fringe evenly.
