MATERIALS

Bernat® Alize® Blanket-EZ Stripes™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 18 yds/16 m)

Contrast A Sweet (46010)

1 ball

Bernat® Alize® Blanket-EZ™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 18 yds/16 m)

Contrast B Candy Pink (37025)

1 ball





ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9" x 70" [23 x 178 cm], excluding loopy edges.

GAUGE

5 stitches = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

- Right side of project is facing at all times
- There are 52 loops per each color section. Only this number of loops will work for striping effect. Determine beginning of a color-change and count exact amount of loops of the same color
- When joining new color, cut base of first and last loops to create ends to secure stitches.

Count first 13 loops of A (lighter color) for foundation row (noting yarn end is at far right and all loops are facing up.

1st row: Working from left to right, with working yarn in back, pull 14th loop (from 'working yarn') up through 13th loop from behind to create a knit stitch. Pull next loop from working yarn up through next loop of foundation row to create next knit stitch. Continue in this manner to end of row. **Do not** turn work. 13 stitches in row. **2nd row:** Working from **right** to left, with working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn towards back through last stitch worked on previous row to create a purl stitch. *Pull next loop from working yarn up through next stitch to create a knit stitch. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch to create a purl stitch. Repeat from * to end of row. **Do not** turn.


3rd row: Working from **left** to **right**, with working yarn in back, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through last stitch worked on previous row. *Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch. Repeat from * to end of row. **Do not** turn.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until Scarf measures approx 35" [89 cm], ending on a 8th row of color repeat. Break A.

With B only, repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until Scarf measures approx 70" [178 cm].

Bind off row: Working in same direction as last row, pull 2nd stitch through first stitch. Pull 3rd stitch through 2nd stitch. Pull 4th stitch through 3rd stitch. Continue in this manner to end of row. Cut last loop to create yarn tail. Pull yarn tail through last loop. Tie to secure and weave in ends.

Make loops in lighter color of A across B end. Make loops in B across A end.



Loopy Edge: Cut base of first loop of A carefully to create a straight length of yarn. Working across Bind Off edge in front loops only, tie end around first st at top right corner. Working from right to left, pull first loop from working yarn up from behind through same sp where straight length of yarn was tied for 1st stitch. Pull next 2 loops from working yarn up from behind through first stitch – First double-loop stitch made. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through front loop of next bind off stitch for 2nd stitch. Pull next 2 loops from working yarn up from behind through 2nd stitch -Second double-loop stitch made. Continue in this manner, until 13 double-loop stitches have been made. Cut last loop to create a yarn 'tail'. Tie to secure and weave in ends.
