



 CRAFT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

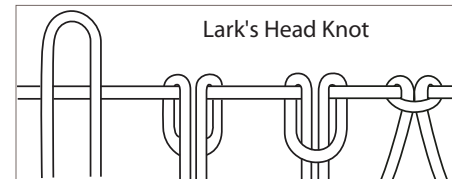
INSTRUCTIONS

Tips:

- Tape dowel to work surface for ease of working.
- Do not tie knots too tightly. Tighten strands just enough to secure knot.

1. Cut 30 strands of yarn approx 5 yds [4.5 m] long.

2. Divide 30 strands into 5 groups of 6 strands. Holding 6 strands together, fold each in half and tie onto dowel using Larks Head knot (see diagram). Repeat for each of group.



3. Adjust knots on dowel so they are evenly spaced.

4. Divide each group into 4 groups of 3 strands. **From this point on**, hold these 3 strands together and treat each group of 3 as one strand.

Work Square Knot Rows as Follows: Square Knot Row One: Tie one square knot in each of the 5 groups, working 4" [10 cm] down from dowel. (5 knots in this row) See diagram on page 2.

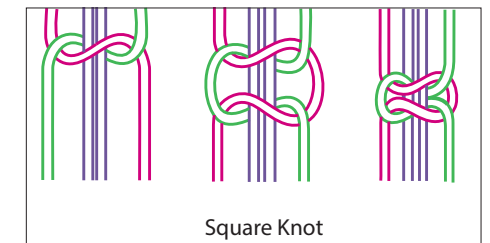
Square Knot Row 2: Taking the right-most 2 strands from the first group and left-most 2 strands from the second group, tie one square knot 4" [10 cm] down from previous knot. Repeat across, working knots with 2 strands from groups 2 and 3, groups 3 and 4 and groups 4 and 5. (4 knots in this row)

Square Knot Row 3: Taking the left-most 2 strands from the first group and left-most 2 strands from the second group, tie one square knot 4" [10 cm] down from previous knot.

Taking the right-most 2 strands from the second group and left-most 2 strands from the 3rd group, tie one square knot 4" [10 cm] down from previous knot. Repeat across, working knots with 2 strands from groups 3 and 4 and groups 4 and 5. (5 knots in this row).

Square Knot Rows 4 through 7: Repeat Square Knot Rows Three and Four.

Trim fringe evenly.



MATERIALS

Bernat® Maker™ Home Dec (8.8 oz/1250 g; 317 yds /290 m)

Clay (11008) **1 ball**

Wooden dowel approx 24" [60 cm] long. Tape. Ruler or measuring tape. Scissors.
