Bernat[®] Macrame[™] (8.8 oz/250 g; 44 yds/40 m)

Taupe (66002)

2 balls

Transparent tape. Wooden ring approx 2¹/₂" [6 cm] in diameter. Hair comb for fringe.




INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:


- Tape ring to flat work surface for ease of working.
- Do not tie knots too tightly. Tighten cords just enough to secure knot.
- Text in **bold** refers to knots illustrated with diagrams.


Reverse Lark's Head Knot






Square Knot











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INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut 6 cords 10 yds [9.25 m] long.
- 2. Fold cords in half and tie in **Reverse Lark's Head Knot** to ring.
- 3. Divide cords into 3 groups of 4 cords.
- 4. With one group of 4 cords, tie **Half Knot** as follows:
 - Left and right-most cords are knotting cords. 2 cords in center are knot-bearing cords.
 - Bring the left knotting cord to the right over the two knot-bearing cords and underneath the right knotting cord.

- Bring the right knotting cord to the left under the two knot-bearing cords and over the left knotting cord.
- Pull knotting cords to secure the knot.



5. Repeat Step 4 to create **Half Knot** Sennit measuring 20" [51 cm] from ring (knots will naturally form spiral).



6. Repeat Steps 3 and 4 to create Half Knot Sennits with remaining 2 groups of 4 cords.



- 7. Take one knotting cord and one knot-bearer cord from first group and second group together to form new group of 4 cords.
- 8. Tie **Square Knot** 5" [12.5 cm] below last **Half Knot** of **Half Knot** Sennit.







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9. Continue to tie **Square Knots** 11. Repeat Steps 8 and 9 for new to create Square Knots sennit 6" [15 cm] long.





10. Take remaining cords from second group and one knotting from third group to create new group of 4 cords.



- 12. Take remaining cords from third and first groups to create new group of 4 cords.
- cord and one knot-bearer cord 13. Repeat Steps 8 and 9 for new group of 4 cords.

- 14. Cut new cord 2 yd [1.8 m] long. With new cord, tie **Gathering** Knot around all cords close to end of Square Knot Sennits. Trim ends of cord close to knot.
- 15. Trim loose cords 16" [40.5 cm] from Gathering Knot.



16. Un-ply each loose cord by twisting cord clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot. Comb fringe and trim evenly.
