

MATERIALS
Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Macrame ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( 8.8 oz/250 g; 44 yds/40 m)
Burnt Orange (66004) 1 ball makes 4 coasters
Transparent Tape.
Hair comb for fringe.

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## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 4" [10 cm] wide x $61 / 2{ }^{1}$ [ 16.5 cm ] long including fringe.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Tape cords to flat work surface for ease of working.
- Text in bold refers to knots illustrated with diagrams.

Instructions for Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row
First cord on the left is "knotbearer". With next cord to the right, tie Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working left-to-right, continue tying Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot to knotbearer using next cord to the right of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

## Instructions for Right-Left

 Double Half Hitch RowLast cord on the right is "knotbearer". With next cord to the left, tie Horizontal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working right-to-left, continue tying Horizontal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot to knotbearer using next cord to the left of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

## Coaster Instructions

1. Cut 10 knotting cords 30 " [ 76 cm ] long and 1 knot-bearer cord 35" [89 cm].
2. Tape top of all cords to work surface having 35" [89 cm ] knot-bearer cord on left side.
3. Holding knot-bearer cord horizontally and in front of knotting cords, work Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row. Knotbearer is now at right side.
4. Holding knot-bearer cord horizontally and in front all knotting cords, work Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row.
5. Repeat Steps 3 and 4 twice more and then repeat Step 3 once more.
6. Trim ends to 1 " $[2.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
7. Un-ply each loose end by twisting cord clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot.
8. Comb fringe and trim evenly.
