**Bernat® Macrame™** (8.8 oz/250 g; 44 yds/40 m)

Natural (66001)

**1 ball**

8" [20.5 cm] diameter metal ring. 14" [35.5 cm] diameter metal ring.

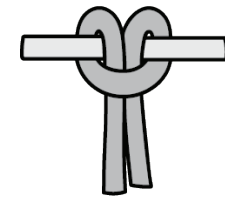
Approx 14" [35.5 cm] wide x 34" [86.5 cm] long.

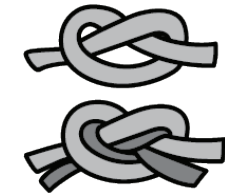
**Note:** Text in **bold** refers to knots illustrated with diagrams.

### Instructions for Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row

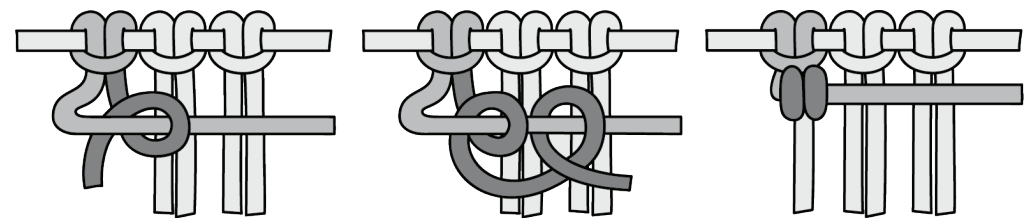
Hoop is "knot-bearer". With first cord to the left, tie **Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot** onto knot-bearer. Working left-to-right, continue tying **Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot** to knot-bearer using next cord to the right of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch

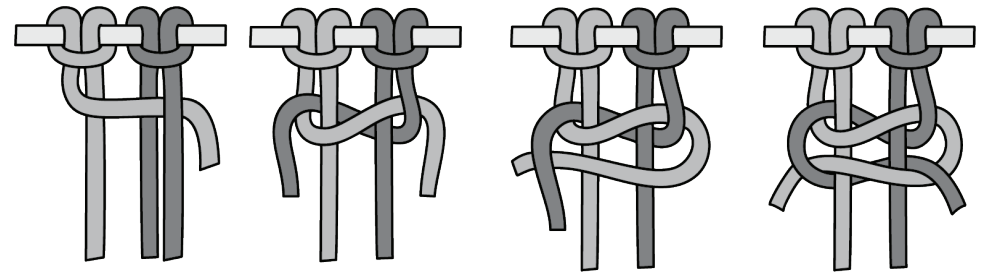
### Hanging Loop

1. Cut 1 cord 14" [35.5 cm] long.
2. Fold cord in half and tie hoops together with **Lark's Head Knot**.
3. Using both cords, tie **Overhand Knot** 2" [5 cm] from end of cords for hanging loop.
4. Trim ends close to knot.

### Wall Hanging

1. Cut 15 cords 60" [152.5 cm] long.
2. Fold cords in half and tie each cord to 8" [20.5 cm] hoop.
3. Skip first 6 cords. With next 6 cords, tie **Square Knot** 2" [5 cm] down from hoop as follows:
  - Left and right-most cords are knotting cords. 4 cords in center are knot-bearing cords.
  - Bring the left knotting cord to the right over the 4 knot-bearing cords and underneath the right knotting cord.
  - Bring the right knotting cord to the left under the 4 knot-bearing cords and over the left knotting cord.

- Pull knotting cords to secure the knot.
  - Bring the right knotting cord to the left over the 4 knot-bearing cords and underneath the left knotting cord.
  - Bring the left knotting cord to the right under the 4 knot-bearing cords and over the right knotting cord.
  - Pull knotting cords to secure.
4. Repeat **Square Knot** as described across each of next 2 sets of 6 cords. Leave last 6 cords unworked.
  5. Pulling tight and having 14" [35.5 cm] hoop as knot bearer, work **Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row**, starting with left-most cord and working across to last cord on the right.
  6. Trim ends of cords as shown in photo.



### Square Knot

Note: Pattern differs from diagram above using 4 cords for knot-bearing cords at center.
