ABBREVIATIONS

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 30" x 25" [76 x 63.5 cm] tall.

INSTRUCTIONS

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove

- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H and I). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H and I.

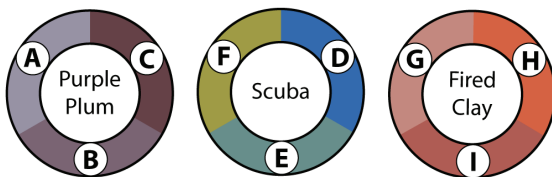
MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ O'Go™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A, B and C: Purple Plum (42012) **1 O'Go**

Contrast D, E and F: Scuba (42015) **1 O'Go**

Contrast G, H and I: Fired Clay (42008) **1 O'Go**



White felt, 8 feet [2.5 m] of foam insulation tubing with peel & stick adhesive, hot glue gun, scissors, piece of 5" [12.5 cm] cardboard for tassels.

RAINBOW

Step 1: Cut the foam insulation tubing lengthwise down the center. Peel & stick the tubing to itself to form 2 lengths of tubing that are 8 feet [2.5 m] long each.

Step 2: Cut tubing into 9 graduating lengths for a rainbow. See finished photo for details.

Step 3: Cut white felt into strips. Wrap tube and hot glue in place.

Step 4: Beginning with the shortest piece of tubing and A, wrap piece, covering all of the white felt.

Step 5: Fold in half and tie (with A) to secure. See finished photo for details.

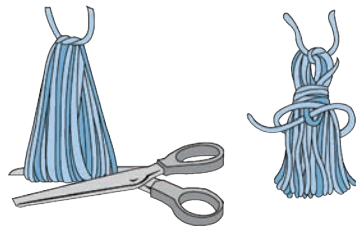
Step 6: Using B and next longest piece of tubing, repeat Step 4.

Step 7: Hot glue wrapped tubing around the arch of previous one.

Step 8: Repeat Steps 6 and 7 until all tubing pieces are wrapped and glued together.

Tassels (make 2 in each color):

Wrap yarn around a 5" [12.5 cm] piece of cardboard 12 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap yarn twice around tassel 1½" [4 cm] from tied end and fasten securely.



Assembly

Using hot glue, attach tassels to bottoms of the matching arches of the rainbow.
