

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Macrame ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $8.8 \mathrm{oz} / 250 \mathrm{~g} ; 44 \mathrm{yds} / 40 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Autum Rose (66016), or Natural (66001), or Sunshine (66012) 1 ball $3 / 4$ " $[2 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] diameter wooden dowel 8 " [ 12.5 cm ] long. Comb.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" x 25" [20.5 x 63.5 cm ], excluding hanging loop.

## Notes:

- Text in bold refers to knots illustrated with diagrams.
- Do not tie knots tightly; doing so will alter finished measurements

Instructions for Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row: First cord on the left is "knotbearer". With next cord to the right, tie Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working left-to-right, continue tying Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knots to knotbearer using next cord to the right of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.


HORIZONTAL LEFT-RIGHT DOUBLE HALF HITCH KNOT

Instructions for Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row: Last cord on the right is "knotbearer". With next cord to the left, tie Horizontal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working right-to-left, continue tying Horizontal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knots to knotbearer using next cord to the left of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

## Instructions for Left-Right

 Diagonal Double Half Hitch Row: First cord on the left is ""'knot-bearer". With next cord to the right, tie Diagonal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working left-to-right, continue tying Diagonal LeftRight Double Half Hitch Knot to knot-bearer using next cord to the right of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

## DIAGONAL LEFT-RIGHT DOUBLE HALF HITCH KNOT

Instructions for Right-Left Diagonal Double Half Hitch Row: Last cord on the right is ""knot-bearer". With next cord to the left, tie Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot onto knot-bearer. Working right-to-left continue tying Diagonal RightLeft Double Half Hitch Knot to knot-bearer using next cord to the left of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

## WALL HANGING

1. Cut 8 cords 90 " $[228.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long.
2. Fold each cord in half and tie to dowel using Lark's Head Knot.


> LARK'S HEAD KNOT
3. Holding left-most cord horizontally and in front of other cords, work Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row.
4. With first 4 cords, tie Half Knots until work measures 3" [ 7.5 cm ]. Repeat across each of next 3 groups of 4 cords.


HALF KNOT
5. Holding right-most cord horizontally and in front of other cords, work Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row.
6. Working from left-to-right with groups of 4 cords, tie Square Knots across all cords.
7. Skip first 2 cords. (Square Knot over next 4 cords) 3 times. Leave last 2 cords unworked.

8. Skip first 4 cords. (Square Knot over next 4 cords) twice. Leave last 4 cords unworked.
9. Skip first 6 cords. Square Knot over next 4 cords. Leave last 4 cords unworked.
10. With first cord from left as knot-bearer, work Diagonal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row with next 7 cords. With last cord on right as knotbearer, work Diagonal RightLeft Double Half Hitch Row with remaining cords.
11. Skip first 6 cords. Square Knot over next 4 cords. Leave last 4 cords unworked.
12. Trim ends so total length of Wall Hanging is 25 " $[63.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
13. Cut 2 cords 14" [ 35.5 cm ] long.
14. Fold each cord in half and tie one at either side of cords previously attached to dowel.
15. Bring cords together at top of work and tie overhand knot.
16. Un-ply loose end of each cord by twisting cord clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot Comb fringe and trim evenly
