



CRAFT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approximately 14" x 24"  
[35.5 x 61 cm]

### **GAUGE**

5 stitches and 4 rows = 4" [10 cm].

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Right side of project is facing at all times. **Do not** turn work at end of rows.
- Pillow is worked in rounds
- For Knit rounds 'Working yarn' is held behind stitches
- For Purl rounds 'Working yarn' is held in front of stitches
- Replace marker at end of every round
- To change color, cut last loop of working yarn to create a tail. Cut base of first loop of adjoining color to create a tail. Tie both ends together at wrong side of work, so first loop of contrast color will be next working loop.

Cut first loop of MC close to base to create a tail approximately 3" [7.5 cm] long. Count 38 loops for foundation round. Tie tail to yarn between 38th and 39th loops to create ring. Place all loops facing upwards.

**1st round:** Working from **right to left**, with working yarn in back, pull 39th loop (from 'working yarn') up from behind through 1st loop on foundation round to create a knit stitch. \*Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next loop of foundation round. Repeat from \* around. **Do not** turn. Place safety pin between first and last stitches of round to mark end of round.

**2nd to 6th rounds:** Working from **right to left**, with working yarn at back, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through 1st stitch worked on previous round to create a knit stitch. \*Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch. Repeat from \* around. **Do not** turn. Replace safety pin to mark end of round.

### **MATERIALS**

**Bernat® Alize® EZ Wool™** (5.3 oz/150 g; 11 yds/10 m)

**Main Color (MC)** Cream (09001) **2 balls**

**Contrast A** Wheatberry (09002) **1 ball**

**Contrast B** Flannel (09005) **1 ball**

14" x 24" [35.5 x 61 cm] pillow form. Safety pin.

## BERNAT® LET'S FRINGE EZ PILLOW

**\*\*7th round:** (Loopy round). Fold row of loops from previous row towards lower edge exposing horizontal 'bump' behind each st. *Working from right to left*, pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through first exposed 'bump' from previous row. \*Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next exposed 'bump'. Repeat from \* around. **Do not** turn. Replace safety pin to mark end of round. Break MC, leaving end for joining A.

**8th round:** With A, as 7th round.

**9th and 10th rounds:** With A, as 2nd round.

**11th round:** (Purl round). *Working from right to left*, with working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn up towards back through last stitch worked on previous row to create a purl stitch. \*With working yarn at front, pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch. Repeat from around. **Do not** turn. Replace safety pin to mark end of round. Break A, leaving end for joining B.

**12th round:** With B, as 2nd round.

**13th round:** With B, as 11th round. Break B, leaving end for joining MC.

**14th and 15th rounds:** With B, as 2nd round.

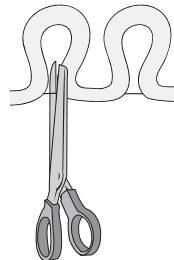
**16th round:** With MC, as 2nd round.

**17th and 18th rounds:** With MC, as 7th round.

**19th to 24th rounds:** With MC, as 2nd round.

**Bind off round:** With MC, working in **same direction as last round**, pull 2nd stitch through first stitch. Pull 3rd stitch through 2nd stitch. Pull 4th stitch through 3rd stitch. Continue in this manner to end of round. Cut last loop to create yarn tail. Pull yarn tail through last loop. Tie to secure and weave in ends.

**Fringe:** Cut base of A and B loops carefully to create a straight length of yarn approximately 90" [230 cm] long (will be cut to make fringe) of each color. Cut strands of yarn 10" [25.5 cm] long.



Fold 1 strand in half and having first row at bottom, knot A into fringe across purl ridges of A sections. Trim fringe evenly.

Turn Pillow up-side down with first row at top, knot B into fringe across purl ridges of B sections. Trim fringe evenly.

Fold Pillow flat. Sew top seam. Insert pillow form. Sew opening closed.
