MEASUREMENT

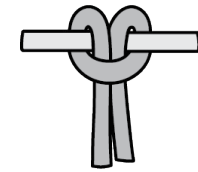
Approx 4" [10 cm] in diameter, excluding fringe.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

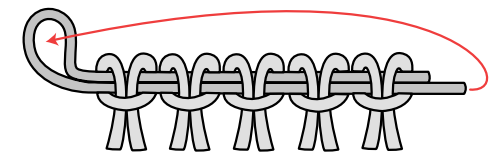
- Text in bold refers to knots illustrated with diagrams.
- **Do not** tie knots tightly; doing so will alter finished measurement.

1. Cut one knot-bearing cord 60" [152.5 cm] long in A. Cut 11 knotting cords 36" [91.5 cm] long in A. Cut 4 knotting cords 36" [91.5 cm] long in B.
2. Place knot-bearing cord flat on table, folding to form a 18" [45.5 cm] overlap.
3. Working over both cords as shown in diagram, work 5 **Lark's Head** knots, working center knot with a knotting cord in B, and all others with knotting cords in A.

4. Take long end of knot-bearing cord and thread it through loop as shown in diagram. Draw tight to form circle which will form center of Coaster. Shorter end of knot-bearing cord will now be used as a knotting cord.



MATERIALS

Bernat® Macrame™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 44 yds/40 m)

Version 1 (makes 4 coasters)

Contrast A Natural (66001) **1 ball**

Contrast B Sunshine (66012) **1 ball**

Version 2 (makes 4 coasters)

Contrast A Natural (66001) **1 ball**

Contrast B Autumn Rose (66016) **1 ball**

Yarn needle. Hair comb for fringe.

ABBREVIATION

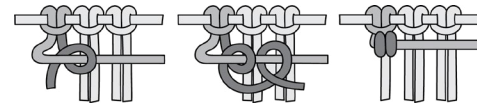

5. Holding knot-bearer cord horizontally and in front of knotting cords, work a **Horizontal Double Half Hitch** using short end of knot-bearing cord as knotting cord. Continue working **Horizontal Double Half Hitch** knots using each of next two knotting cords. With a new knotting cord in A, work a **Lark's Head** knot around knotting cord. Continue working **Horizontal Double Half Hitch** knots around knot-bearing cord using each of next three knotting cords. With a new knotting cord in B, work a **Lark's Head** knot around knot-bearing cord. Continue working **Horizontal Double Half Hitch** knots around knot-bearing cord using each of next 3 knotting cords. With a new knotting cord in A, work a **Lark's Head** knot around knotting cord.

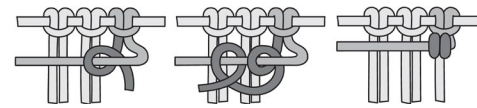
6. Continue as established until Coaster measures approx 4" [10 cm] in diameter, working **Horizontal Double Half Hitch** knots using existing knotting cords, and adding in new knotting cords in the appropriate shade whenever a gap appears. When adding in new knotting cords, place new cords **in between** 2 existing knotting cords of same shade. This will maintain tidy lines within colorwork.

7. Once completed, there should be approx 31 knotting cord tails in project – 23 in A, 8 in B. Using yarn needle, weave tail of knot-bearing cord into back of work. Trim all knotting cords to 1" [2.5 cm].

8. Un-ply each fringe strand by twisting strand clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot. Comb fringe and trim evenly.
