



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

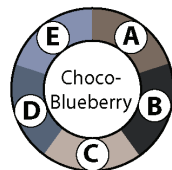
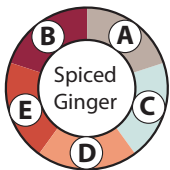
Alt = Alternate
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Pat = Pattern
Prev = Previous(ly)
Rem = Remaining
Rep = Repeat
Rnd = Round
RS = Right side
Sc = Single crochet

Scbl = Single crochet in back loop only
Scbl2tog = Draw up a loop in back loops only of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

Sc3tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 3 sc. Yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook
Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

Caron® Big Donut™ O'Go™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 502 yds/459 m)
 Spiced Ginger (29001) or Choco-Blueberry (29010) 1 O'Go



OR

Sizes U.S. H/8 [5 mm] and U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge. 4 stitch markers. Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14" [35.5 cm] wide across shoulder x 10" [25.5 cm] deep from shoulder.

GAUGE

13 scbl and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.

- Separate colors by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D and E). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label the bag – A, B, C, D, E.

Notes:

- Neckwarmer is worked sideways.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook of first colour. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed in next color.
- All rnds are join with sl st to first sc.

BACK

With larger hook and C, ch 33.

****Right Shoulder: 1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 32 sc.

2nd and alt rows: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 20 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 10 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

7th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 5 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

9th row: Ch 1. *Working across entire row and all prev skipped sts,* (1 scbl in each of next 5 sts. 1 sc into side edge of last 2 rows) twice. 1 scbl in each of next 10 sts. 1 sc into side edge of last 2 rows. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 35 sc. Place marker for Neck at end of row.

10th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row.**
Rep last row until work from marker measures 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Break C.

Next row: (RS). With D, ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from color change measures 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Place marker for Neck at end of last row.

*****Left Shoulder: 1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 5 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. 5 sts.

2nd and alt rows: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 4 sts. Sc3tog, drawing up first loop in back loop only of next st, 2nd loop in side edge of last 2 rows and 3rd loop in back loop only of next st 2 rows below. 1 scbl in each of next 5 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. 10 sts.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 9 sc. Sc3tog, drawing up first loop in back loop only of next st, 2nd loop in side edge of last 2 rows and 3rd loop in back loop only of next st 2 rows below. 1 scbl in each of next 10 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. 20 sts.

7th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 19 sc. Sc3tog, drawing up first loop in back loop only of next st, 2nd loop in side edge of last 2 rows and 3rd loop in back loop only of next st 2 rows below. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 32 sts.

8th and 9th rows: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. Fasten off. ***

Border: With RS facing and larger hook, join D with sl st to top edge of Back at center color change (noting Back is worked sideways and longer edge is top). Work sc evenly around all sides of Back, working 3 sc in each corner and changing to C at center bottom color change. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

FRONT

With larger hook and B, ch 33. Work from ** to ** as given for Back. 35 sts.

Shape Left Neck: 11th row: (RS). Ch 1. Scbl2tog. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 34 sts.

12th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to last 2 sts. Scbl2tog. Turn. 33 sts.

13th row: Ch 1. Scbl2tog. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 32 sts.

14th and 15th rows: Rep last 2 rows once more. 30 sts.

16th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Place second marker. Turn.

Rep last row until work from Neck (first) marker measures 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Break B.

Next row: (RS). With E, ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until work from color change measures same as distance between last 2 markers, ending on a WS row.

Shape Right Neck: 1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 2 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 31 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to last st. 2 scbl in last st. Turn. 32 sts.
3rd row: 2 scbl in first st. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn. 33 sts.
Rep last 2 rows once more. 35 sts.
4th row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

Work from *** to *** as given for Back.

Border: With B and E, work as given for Back Border, matching colors.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams between side edges to markers.

Neck edging: (RS). With larger hook, join A with sl st to left shoulder seam.
Ch 1. Work sc evenly around neck opening. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Collar
With smaller hook and A, ch 12.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to to end of chain. Turn. 11 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until long edge of Collar measures length to fit around neck edge when slightly stretched. Fasten off.
Beg at right shoulder seam, sew long edge of Collar to neck. Sew foundation row and last row of Collar tog.
