



## MATERIALS

**Caron® Simply Soft™ or Caron® Simply Soft Brights™** (6 oz/170 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Neon Pink (39775)

**1 ball or 68 yds/62 m**

or Iris (39747)

or Super Duper Yellow (B9612)

or Limelight (B9607)

or Blue Mint (B9608)

**Note:** 1 ball will make 5 Scrunchies.

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Standard elastic hair ties approx 1½" [4 cm] diameter. Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® Split-lock stitch count markers.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =  
Approximately  
**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Rep** = Repeat  
**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)  
**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st** = Slip stitch  
**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**Tog** = Together

## MEASUREMENT

To cover standard hair tie, approx 1½" [4 cm] diameter.

## GAUGE

13 single crochet (sc) and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm]

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Scrunchie is worked in a continuous spiral around elastic hair tie.
- To keep track of rounds (rnds), place a stitch marker in the 1st stitch of each rnd.

Chain (ch) 13. Wrap chain around elastic hair tie and then join chain with slip stitch (sl st) to first ch to form ring, being careful to not twist chain.

**1st round (rnd):** Ch 1. 1 single crochet (sc) in first ch. 1 sc in each ch around. **Do not** join, work in continuous rounds (spiral). 13 sc.

**2nd rnd:** 1 sc in each sc around. Working around elastic hair tie, repeat (rep) last rnd 61 times more. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing. 63 rnds total.

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, sew first and last rnds together (tog) with a flat seam.
