## MAKE THIS

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

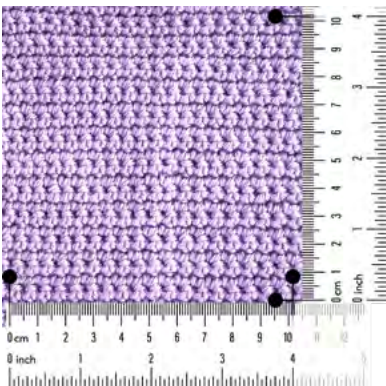


SHOP KIT

### GAUGE

18 single crochet (sc) and 23 rows = 4" [10 cm].

See Gauge Swatch Pattern instructions. Crochet a swatch to check your gauge before starting project pieces to ensure correct measurements.



### YARN

**Caron® Simply Soft®**  
(6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)

### COLORS

Quantity

- **Contrast A** Orchid (39717)  
1 ball or 165 yds/151 m
- **Contrast B** Persimmon (39754)  
1 ball or 102 yds/93 m
- **Contrast C** Fuchsia (39764)  
1 ball or 102 yds/93 m

### TOOLS

- Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® steel yarn needle.
- Pair of purchased 10" [25.5 cm] bag handles.
- Tape measure.

**MEASUREMENT**

Approximately (Approx) 10" [25.5 cm] square, excluding handles.

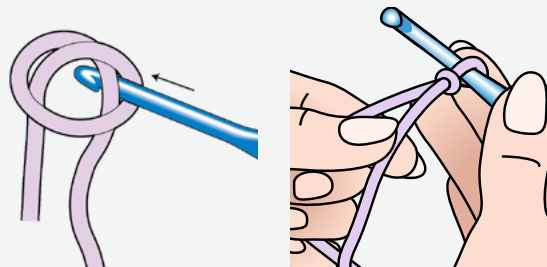
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**INSTRUCTIONS**

**Gauge Swatch Pattern (Pat)**

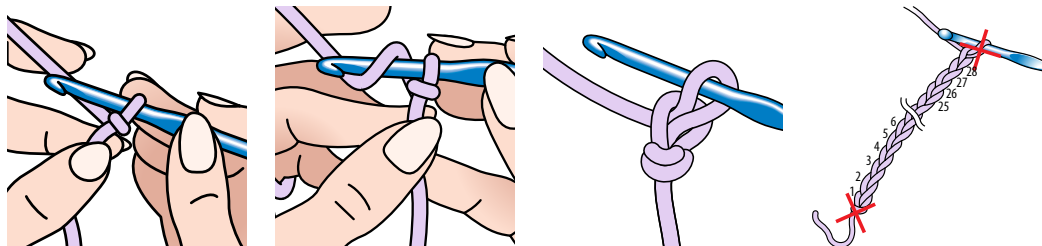
With A make a **Slip Knot**: Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape. Then pull through to make slip knot.



With A, chain (ch) 28.

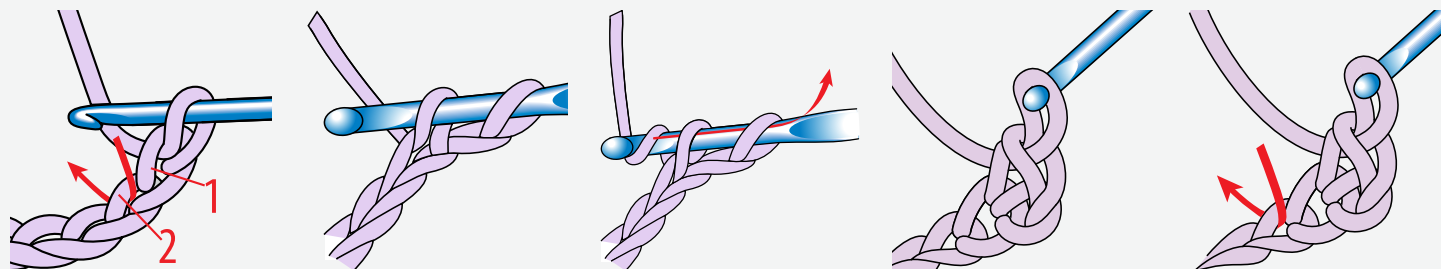
**Chain:**

Yarn over hook (Yoh) and draw up a loop - 1 chain made.

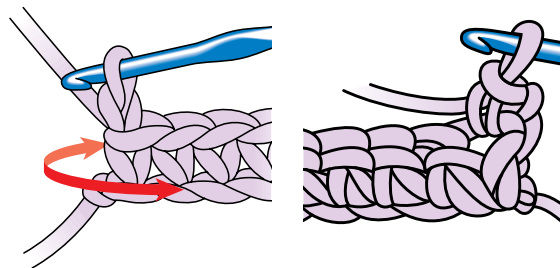


Repeat (rep) last step 27 times more - 28 chains made.

**1st row:** 1 **single crochet** (sc) in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 27 sc.



**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.



Repeat (rep) 2nd row until work from beginning (beg) measures 6" [15 cm] Fasten off.

Measure your completed Gauge Swatch to determine if 18 single crochet (sc) across = 4" [10 cm] and 23 rows high = 4" [10 cm]. If you have fewer than 18 sc across, your crochet is loose and you will need to change to a smaller hook to achieve correct gauge. If you have more than 18 sc across, your crochet is tight and you will need to change to a larger hook to achieve correct gauge.

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**INSTRUCTIONS**

**TOTE**

**Stripe Pattern (Pat)**

With A, work 4 rows. Join B. Break A.  
 With B, work 4 rows. Join C. Break B.  
 With C, work 4 rows. Join A. Break C.  
 These 12 rows form Stripe Pat.

**Notes:**

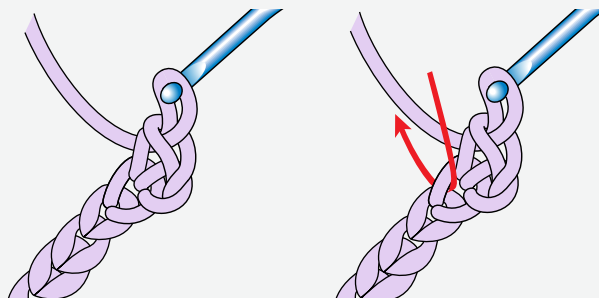
- Stitches (sts) are worked into back loops only throughout.
- Worked over foundation chain (ch) multiple of 14 ch +2.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.

With A make a **slip knot** and loosely **chain** (ch) 72.



See diagram on page 6.

**1st row:** [Right Side (RS)]. 2 **single crochet** (sc) in 2nd ch from hook.



\*1 sc in each of next 6 ch. Skip 1 ch. 1 sc in each of next 6 ch. 3 sc in next ch. Repeat (rep) from \* to end of chain, ending last rep with 2 sc in last ch. Turn. 76 sc.

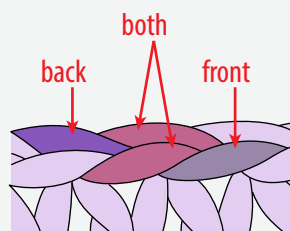


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**INSTRUCTIONS**

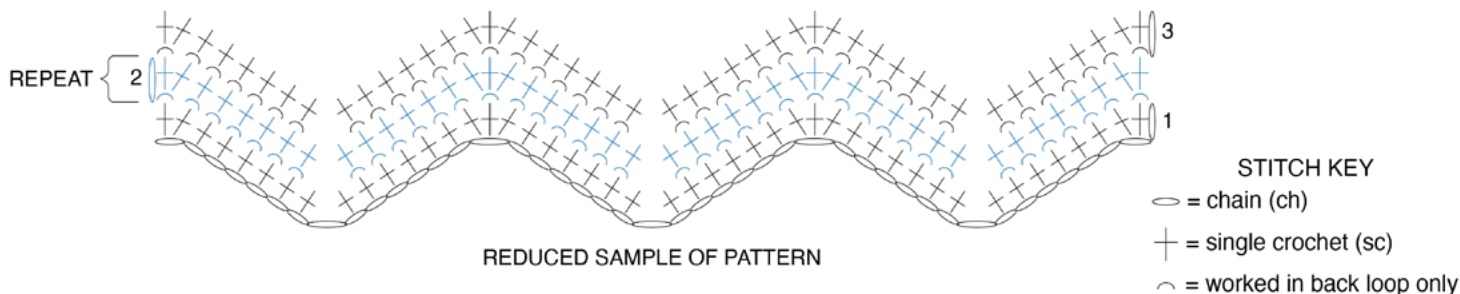
**2nd row:** Ch 1. Working into back loops only of each st, 2 sc in first sc. \*1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Skip next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. 3 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row, ending last rep with 2 sc in last sc. Turn.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.



**NOTE: Changing Colors** (first change happens after 4th row)

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.



Keeping continuity (cont) of Stripe Pat, rep 2nd row until work measures approx 20" [51 cm] long measured from valley to valley, ending on any 4th row of Stripe Pat. **Fasten off. Weave in ends.**

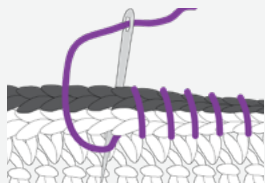

**FINISHING**

Aligning first and last row so that peaks are even, sew side seams together (tog), using **whipstitch**, from bottom fold up to bottom line of valleys approx 1" [2.5 cm] from top edge.



Whipstitch



**Peaked Edge Handle:**

Attach handle by wrapping 5 peaks around handle and fastening securely in place on inside of Bag.



**Valley Edge Handle:**

Attach handle by wrapping 4 central peaks around handle and fastening securely in place on inside of Bag. Wrap two half edge peaks to inside and fasten securely inside Bag.
