



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>Approx</b> =	<b>Dc</b> = Double crochet	<b>RS</b> = Right side
Approximately	<b>Pat</b> = Pattern	<b>Sp(s)</b> = Space(s)
<b>Ch</b> = Chain(s)	<b>PM</b> = Place marker	<b>St(s)</b> = Stitch(es)
<b>Cont</b> = Continue(ity)	<b>Rep</b> = Repeat	<b>Tog</b> = Together

## MEASUREMENTS

**One Size Fits All:** Approximately (Approx) 38" [96.5 cm] wide x 24" [61 cm] long.

**Each Panel:** Approx 48" [122 cm] wide x 19" [48.5 cm] tall.

## GAUGE

13.5 sts and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pattern (pat).

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

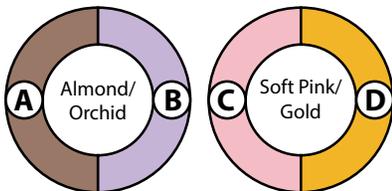
- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Designate each color A, B, C, and D as indicated in Materials.

## MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® O'Go™ (5 oz/141 g; 250 yds/228 m)

**Contrast A & B** Almond/Orchid (40029)      **2 O'Gos**

**Contrast C & D** Soft Pink/Gold (40018)      **3 O'Gos**



Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Yarn needle. 4 stitch markers.

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed in new color.
- Poncho is worked in 2 Panels and seamed together in Finishing.

## PANEL (make 2)

### Stripe Pattern (Pat)

With A, work 12 rows. Join B. Break A.

With B, work 8 rows. Join C. Break B. With C, work 7 rows. Join D. Break C.

With D, work 6 rows.

These 33 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, chain (ch) 25. See diagram on page 3.

**1st row:** (Right side – RS). [3 double crochet (dc). Ch 2. 3 dc] all in 4th ch from hook (counts as 4 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc). \*Ch 1. Skip next 2 ch. 3 dc in next ch. Repeat (rep) from \* to last 3 ch. Ch 1. Skip next 2 ch. (3 dc. Ch 2. 4 dc) all in last ch. Turn. 32 dc.

**2nd row:** Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 space (sp). \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 1 dc in last dc (top of first ch-3). Turn. 35 dc.

**3rd row:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in last dc (top of first ch-3). Turn. 44 dc.

**4th row:** Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 1 dc in last dc (top of first ch-3). Turn. 47 dc.

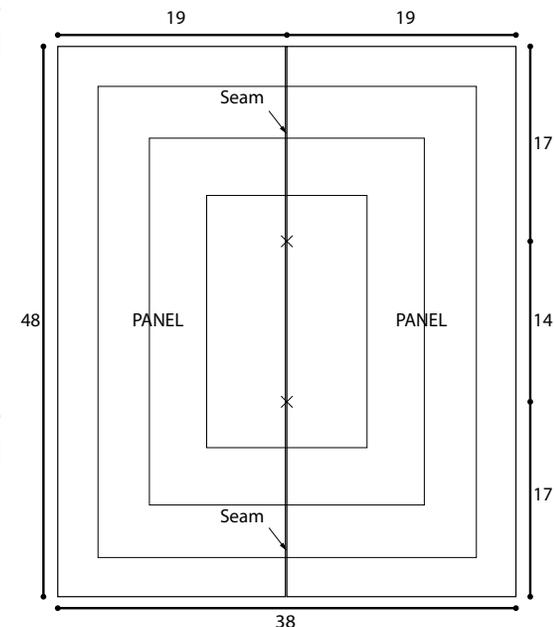
**5th row:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp.\* Rep from \* to \* to next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* to \* to next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* to \*, ending with 3 dc in last ch-1 sp. 1 dc in last dc (top of first ch-3). Turn. 56 dc.

**6th row:** Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp.\* Rep from \* to \* to next ch-2 sp. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* to \* to last 4 dc. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 1 dc in last dc (top of first ch-3). Turn. 59 dc. First 6 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

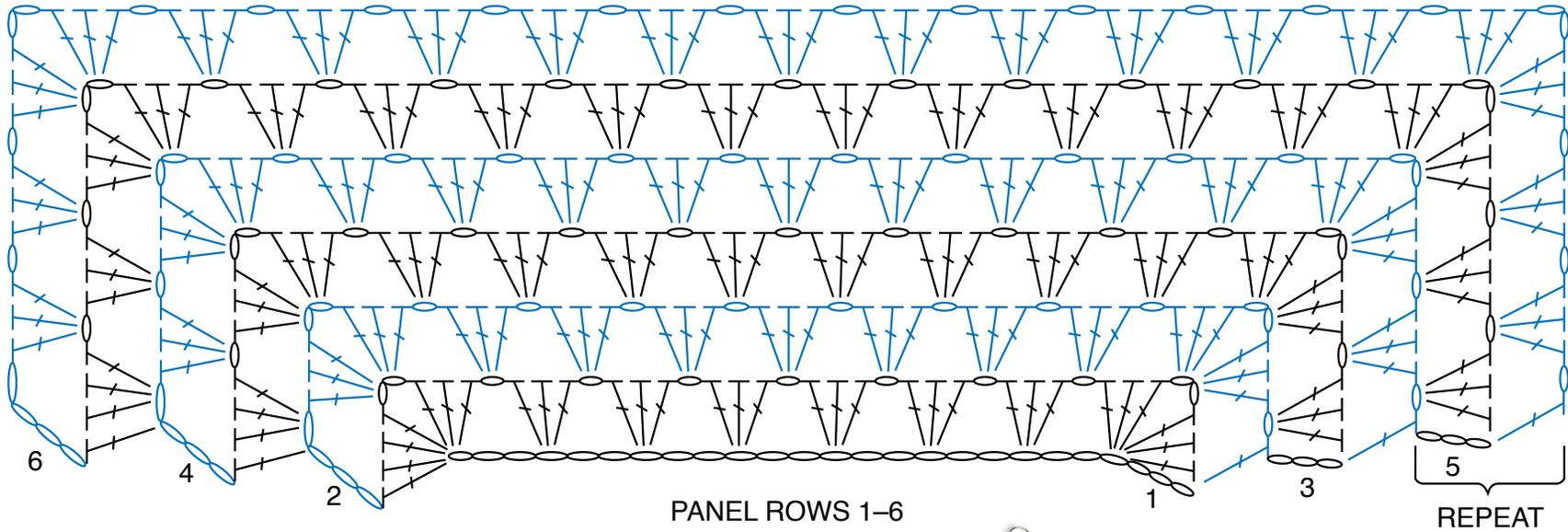
Keeping continuity (cont) of Stripe Pat, rep 5th and 6th rows until 33 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With RS facing, rotate 1 Panel 180 degrees so foundation ch edges align. Place marker (PM) 17" [43 cm] from each end along foundation ch edges on each Panel. Matching stripes and st markers, sew 2 Panels together (tog) using color to match stripe and working from edge to st marker at either end of seam leaving space between st markers, approx 14" [35.5 cm], unseamed (see schematic) for neck opening.
