



 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 32" [81.5 cm] around
x 10" [25.5 cm] deep.

GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4"
[10 cm].

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Contrast A White (9701) **1 ball**

Contrast B Harvest Red (9763) **1 ball**

Contrast C Autumn Red (9730) **1 ball**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: To join new color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw new color through last 2 loops then proceed in new color.

Stripe Pat

With A, work 1 rnd.

With B, work 2 rnds.

With C, work 4 rnds.

With B, work 2 rnds.

With A, work 1 rnd.

These 10 rnds form Stripe Pat.

With A, ch 100. Join with sl st to first ch, taking care to not twist chain.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join B with sl st to first sc. Break A. 100 sc.

2nd rnd: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. First 2 rnds of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in Stripe Pat, rep 2nd rnd until Stripe Pat has been worked 4 times. Fasten off.
