Size U.S. $K/10\frac{1}{2}$ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 33" [84 cm] around x 12" [30.5 cm] deep.

GAUGE

14 sts and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

 Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multishade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone™ color # (see label).
- Designate each yarn ball Contrast, A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results
- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of first color. Yoh with new color, draw through loops and proceed with new color.

Front and Back (make 2 pieces alike)

First Block

With A, ch 31.

1st row: (WS). 1 dc in 5th ch from hook (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc). *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 dc in next ch. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 29 sts.

2nd to 10th rows: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Skip first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. Join B at end of 10th row.

11th to 20th rows: With B, rep 2nd row 10 times more. Fasten off.

Second Block

Turn work 90 degrees clockwise. Join C with sl st to top right corner of work (beg ch).

1st row: (RS). Ch 4 (counts as

1 dc. Ch 1). Work (1 dc. Ch 1) 17 times evenly across side of First Block. 1 dc in last st. Turn. 37 sts. **2nd row:** Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Skip first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end

Rep 2nd row 4 times more. Fasten off.

Third Block

1st row: (WS). Join D with sl st to top right corner of work (First Block). Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Work (1 dc. Ch 1) 19 times evenly across side of First and Second Blocks. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) all in corner. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 42 sts on first side, 38 sts on second side and 1 corner ch-2 sp.

2nd row: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Skip first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to corner ch-2 sp. Ch 1. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) all in corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Rep 2nd row. Fasten off.

Fourth Block


Turn work clockwise 90 degrees. **1st row:** (WS). Join E with sl st to top right corner of work (1st Block). Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Work (1 dc. Ch 1) 20 times evenly across side of Block. 1 dc in corner. Turn. 43 sts.

2nd row: Ch 4 (counts as 1 dc. Ch 1). Skip first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.


3rd to 5th rows: Rep 2nd row 3 times more. Fasten off.

Sew side seams of Front and Back tog.
