



**MATERIALS**

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Version 1 or Version 2

Fuchsia Foliage (01020)

2 braids

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

**ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Hdcbl** = Half double crochet in back loop only of next stitch

**Hdcfl** = Half double crochet in front loop only of next stitch

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Scfl** = Single crochet in front loop only of next stitch

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sl stbl** = Slip stitch in back loop only of next stitch.

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

**MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 25½" [65 cm] around x 12" [30.5 cm] deep.

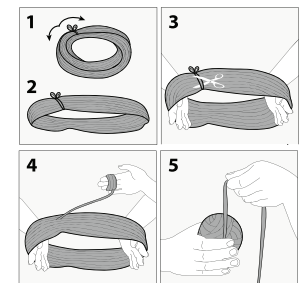
**GAUGE**

12 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

**INSTRUCTIONS**

**Notes:**

- Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone™ color # (see label).
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results
- Worked over foundation ch multiple of 4 ch + 3.
- When joining colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed.

## TOP and BOTTOM

(make 2 pieces alike)

With A, ch 79. See chart on page 3.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 77 sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). 1 dcbp around each st to end of row. Join B. Break A. Turn.

**3rd row:** With B, ch 2 (counts as 1 hdc). 1 hdcbl in each st to end of row. Join C. Break B. Turn.

**4th row:** With C, ch 1. 1 scfl in first st. \*Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 scfl in next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Join D. Break C. Turn.

**5th row:** With D, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join C. Break D. Turn.

**6th row:** With C, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join B. Break C. Turn.

**7th row:** With B, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Join E. Break B. Turn.

**8th row:** With E, ch 1. 1 scfl in each st to end of row. Turn.

**9th row:** Ch 1. 1 sl stbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

**10th row:** Ch 2 (counts as 1 hdc). 1 hdcfl in each sl st to end of row. Join B. Break E. Turn.

**11th row:** With B, ch 1. 1 sc in first st. \*1 sc in next st. *Draw up a long loop in front loop only of sc 4 rows below (7th row). Yoh and draw through 1 loop on hook. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook* – extended sc made. Skip next st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep

from \* to end of row. Join C. Break B. Turn.

**12th row:** With C, ch 1. 1 scfl in each st to end of row. Join D. Break C. Turn.

**13th row:** With D, ch 1. 1 sc in first st. \*Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Join E. Break D. Turn.

**14th row:** With E, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join D. Break E. Turn.

**15th row:** With D, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to end of row. Join C. Break D. Turn.

**16th row:** With C, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Join D. Break C. Turn.

**17th row:** With D, ch 2 (counts as first hdc). 1 hdcbl in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING:

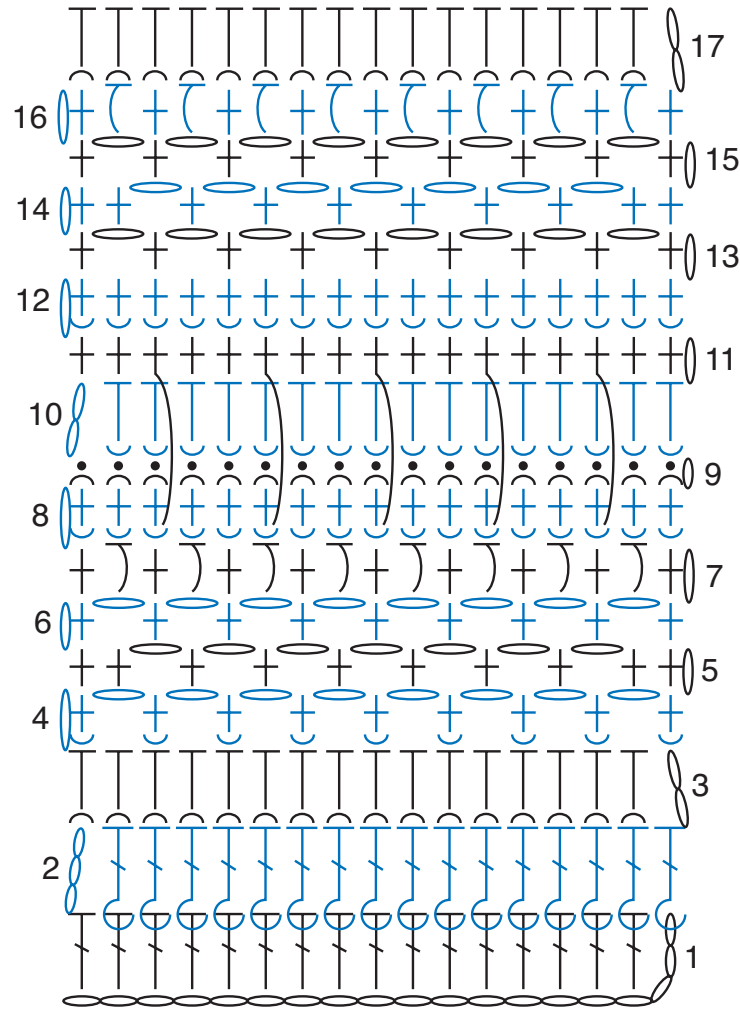
**Joining Top and Bottom:** Place WS of Top and Bottom tog to form a mirror image along final rows. With RS facing, join B with sl st and cont to sl st Top and Bottom tog, *through back loops*

*only* along final rows to create a sl st seam. Sl st seam will create ridge on RS. Fasten off. Sew short edges tog.
