



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Hdc** = Half double  
crochet

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

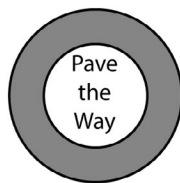
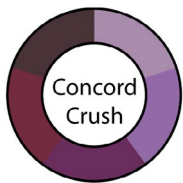
**WS** = Wrong side

## MATERIALS

**Caron® Colorama™ O'Go™** (6.4 oz/180 g; 228 yds/208 m)

**Contrast A** Concord Crush (68019) **1 O'Go**

**Contrast B** Pave the Way (68022) **1 O'Go**



Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 16" [40.5 cm] tall x 26" [66 cm] around.

## GAUGE

9 sts and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start crocheting!

- Cowl is worked in rnds which are joined and turned, alternating RS and WS of work.
- Cowl is reversible. Rnds are noted as RS and WS just for clarity since work is turned at end of each rnd.
- When working into horizontal bar of sts, always work into bar at *side of work facing you*.
- **Do not** cut yarn at end of rnds when changing colors.

- For cleaner color changes at end of rnd, work last st, then bring yarn not in use across top of work. Work joining sl st at over color not in use.

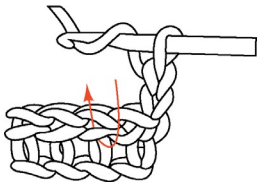
### COWL

With A, ch 58. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring, being careful not to twist.

**Foundation rnd:** (RS). With A, ch 1. Working in back “bumps” of foundation chain, 1 hdc in each ch around. Join with sl st to first hdc.

#### Turn.

**1st rnd:** (WS). With B, ch 1. \*Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked at side of work facing – see diagram). Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first st. **Turn.**



**2nd rnd:** (RS). With A, as 1st rnd. Rep last 2 rnds for pat until work from beg measures 16" [40.5 cm], ending on a 2nd rnd. Fasten off.
