MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Contrast B Light Country Peach (9737) **1 ball**

Contrast D Off White (9702) **1 ball**

Contrast E Light Country Blue (9709) **1 ball**

Contrast F Country Blue (9710) **1 ball**

Contrast G Dark Country Blue (9711) **1 ball**

Caron® Simply Soft® Heathers™ (5 oz/141.7 g; 250 yds/228 m)

Contrast A Gray Heather (H9509) **1 ball**

Contrast C Woodland Heather (H9503) **1 ball**

Size U.S. E/4 (3.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Stitch marker. Stitch holder. Yarn needle.

SIZE

One size to fit Adult palm 7½" [19 cm].

GAUGE

17 sc and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

Work 1 rnd of each color: B, C, D, E, F, B, G, A

These 8 rnds form Stripe Pat.

MITTENS (make 2 alike)

With A, ch 12.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 11 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work, when slightly stretched, from beg measures 7½" [19 cm].** **Do not** fasten off.

1st rnd: Work 28 sc across longer side of ribbing. Join with sl st to first sc.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

1st rnd: With B, ch 4. 1 dc in same sp as sl st – beg V-st made. *Skip next sc. V-st in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. Skip last sc. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 4. Fasten off. 14 V-sts.

2nd rnd: Join C with sl st in first ch-1 sp. Beg V-st in same sp as sl st. *V-st in next V-st. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 4.

First 2 rnds of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last rnd until work after ribbing measures 2½" [6 cm].

Thumb opening: Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

1st rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in first ch-1 sp. Beg V-st in same sp as sl st. V-st in each of next 5 V-sts. Ch 7. Skip next 3 V-sts. V-st in each V-st to end of rnd. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 4.

2nd rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in first ch-1 sp. Beg V-st in same sp as sl st. V-st in each of next 5 V-sts. (Skip next ch. V-st in next ch) 3 times. Skip next ch. V-st in each V-st to end of rnd. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 4. 14 V-sts.

3rd rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in first ch-1 sp. Beg V-st in same sp as sl st. *V-st in next V-st. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 4.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last rnd until work after ribbing measures 6½" [16.5 cm].

Shape top: Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

1st rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in first ch-1 sp. Beg V-st in same sp as sl st. V-st in each of next 5 V-sts. Skip next V-st. V-st in each of next 6 V-sts. Skip last V-st. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 4. 12-V-sts.

2nd rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in first ch-1 sp. Beg V-st in same sp as sl st. Skip next V-st. *V-st in next V-st. Skip next V-st. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 4. 6 V-sts. Fasten off.

Fold top flat. Sew opening closed.

Thumb: Join A with sl st to top of first dc of first skipped V-st. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. (1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each of next dc. Skip next dc) twice. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in next dc. *Working in* rem loops of ch 7, 1 sc in each of next 7 ch. Join with sl st to first sc. in rnd. 13 sc.

Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Rep last rnd until Thumb measures 2" [5 cm].

Next rnd: 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join with sl st to first sc. 12 sts.

Next rnd: (Sc2tog) 6 times. Join with sl st to first st. 6 sts.

Next rnd: (Sc2tog) 3 times. Join with sl st to first st. Fasten off.

Thread yarn through rem 3 sts. Draw up and fasten securely. Sew ends of ribbing.
