Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\oplus}$ ( 6 oz/170 g; $315 \mathrm{yds} / 288 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Both Sizes
Contrast A Off White (9702)
Contrast B Light Country Blue (9709)
1 ball
1 ball
Contrast C Country Blue (9710)
Contrast D Dark Country Blue (9711)
1 ball

Set of 4 size U.S. 6 ( 4 mm ) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker. Stitch holder.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Dec $=$ Decreasing
Inc = Increasing
K = Knit
K1below = Knit into next stitch
1 row below at the same time slipping off stitch above


K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop


P = Purl
P1 below = Purl into next stitch
1 row below at the same time slipping off stitch above Pat = Pattern
PM = Place marker
Rem =Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS = Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit Adult palm 7½ (8½)" [19 $(21.5) \mathrm{cm}]$

## GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows $=4$ " [10 cm $]$ in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

## RIGHT MITTEN

**With set of double-pointed needles and A, cast on 30 (36) sts. Divide onto 3 needles 10 (12) sts on each needle. PM for beg of rnd. 1 st rnd: Knit.
2nd rnd: *K1. P1below. Rep from * around.

Rep these 2 rnds for Shaker Rib Pat for 3" [7.5 cm]. Break A.

Next rnd: With D, [K5 (6). M1] 6 times. 36 (42) sts.
With D, proceed in Seed St Pat as follows:
1st rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around. 2nd rnd: *P1. K1. Rep from * around.
Rep last 2 rnds of Seed St Pat for 2½" [6.5 cm]. Break D.**

Shape thumb opening: 1 st rnd: With B, K18 (21). Slip next 8 sts onto a st holder. Cast on 7 (9) sts. Knit to end of rnd. 35 (43) sts.
***With B, proceed in Mistake Rib Pat as follows:
1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K2. P1.
2nd rnd: P1. K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * around.

Rep last 2 rnds of Mistake Rib Pat for $2122^{\prime \prime}$ [ 6.5 cm ], ending on a RS row and inc (dec) 1 st at end of last rnd. 36 (42) sts. Break B.

With C, proceed in Textured Pat as follows:
1st rnd: Knit.
2nd rnd: Purl.
3rd and 4th rnds: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep 4 last rnds of Textured Pat until work after ribbing measures $6(61 / 2)$ " [15 (16.5) cm], ending on a 4th rnd.

Shape top: Keeping cont of Textured Pat, proceed as follows:
1st rnd: *K4 (5). K2tog. Rep from * around. 30 (36) sts.
2nd rnd: Purl.

## 3rd and 4th rnds: *K1. P1. Rep

 from * around.5th rnd: *K3 (4). K2tog. Rep from * around. 24 (30) sts.
6th to 8th rnds: As 2nd to 4th rnds.
9th rnd: *K2 (3). K2tog. Rep from * around. 18 (24) sts.
10th to 12th rnds: As 2nd to 4th rnds.
13th rnd: *K1 (2). K2tog. Rep from * around. 12 (18) sts.

## Larger size only: 14th to 16th

 rnds: As 2nd to 4th rnds.17th rnd: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 12 sts.

Both sizes: Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 12 sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

Thumb: With B, K8 from st holder. Pick up and knit 8 sts at base of thumb. Divide these 16 sts onto 3 needles $(5,5,6)$. Join in rnd.
Knit 9 rnds even.
Next rnd: (K2. K2tog) 4 times. 12 sts.
Next rnd: (K2tog) 6 times. 6 sts. Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem 6 sts. Draw up and fasten securely.***

## LEFT MITTEN

Work from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *}$ as given for Right Mitten.

## Shape thumb opening: 1st rnd:

 With B, K10 (13). Slip next 8 sts onto a st holder. Cast on 8 sts. Knit to end of rnd. 36 (42) sts.Work from ${ }^{* * *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ as given for Right Mitten.
