

CARON® **MULTI STRIPES CROCHET HAT | CROCHET**



MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz /100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Version 1 or Version 2

Frozen Berry (01022)

2 braids

Sizes U.S. J/10 (6 mm) and U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Hdc = Half double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through

all 3 loops on hook

SI st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

12 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

 Before working with Caron[®] x Pantone[™] multishade varn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid.



Each color link will referenced by its Pantone™ color # (see ball band)

- Designate each yarn ball Contrast, A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results
- Do not break contrast color, carry color not in use loosely up side of work.
- Ribbing and Body of Hat are worked sideways.

Ribbing: With A and larger hook, ch 20.

1st row: (RS). 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 19 sts.


2nd and 3rd rows: With B, ch 1. SI st in each st to end of row. Turn. 4th and 5th rows: With A, ch 1. SI st in each st to end of row. Turn. Last 4 rows form Stripe Pat.

Cont in Stripe Pat until work when slightly stretched measures approx 21" [53.5 cm], ending with 2 rows of B. Fasten off.

Body of Hat: With C and smaller hook, ch 18.

1st row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 16 hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2 (does not count as hdc). 1 hdc in horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS - see diagram) in each st to end of row. Turn.



(Diagram shows WS of work facing)

3rd and 4th rows: With D, as 2nd row.

5th and 6th rows: With C, as 2nd row.

Last 4 rows form Body Stripe Pat. Cont in Body Stripe Pat until work from beg, when slightly stretched, measures 21" [53.5 cm]. Fasten off. Sew side of Ribbing to Body of Hat. Sew back seam, reversing 3½" [9 cm] for turn-back cuff on Ribbing.

Crown: 1st rnd: (RS). With smaller hook, join E with sl st at Hat seam. Ch 1. Work 57 sc evenly around top edge of Hat. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 49 sts.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 41 sts.

4th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 33 sts.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 25 sts.

6th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 17 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely.
