MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)Version 1 or Version 2Peach Blush Parfait (01011)2 braids


Version 3

Faerie Cakes (01023)

2 braids

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Beg = Begin(ning)
Ch = Chain(s)
Cont = Continue
Pat = Pattern
Rep = Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
Sc = Single crochet

SIZE

One size to fit adult.

### GAUGE

12 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Colorwork Pat.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Notes:

Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multishade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid.



Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each
of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw
through all 3 loops on hook
Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
Yoh = Yarn over hook

- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone™ color # (see label).
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results
- When working from chart and joining new color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Carry color when not in use loosely across top of previous rnd and work sts around it to avoid stranding.

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#### With E ch 10.

**1st row:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 9 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 21" [53.5 cm] when slightly stretched. Do not fasten off.

Join last row and first row tog with 1 row of sc to form tube. Break E.

#### Beg working in rnds:

**Foundation rnd:** (RS). Join B with sl st at seam. Ch 1. Working along side edge of ribbing, work 64 sc evenly around. Join with sl st to first sc. Place marker at end of rnd.

**1st to 18th rnds:** Ch 1. Work Chart to end of chart, noting 4-st rep will be worked 16 times. Join with sl st to first sc at end of each rnd.

When Chart is complete break D and cont with C.

**Shape top: 1st rnd:** Ch 1. \*1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 56 sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1. \*1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from \* around Join with sl st to first sc. 48 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. \*1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 40 sc. 4th rnd: Ch 1. \*1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 32 sc. **5th rnd:** Ch 1. \*1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from \* around Join with sl st to first sc. 24 sc. 6th rnd: Ch 1. \*1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 16 sc. 7th rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. Rep from \* around. 8 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and secure tightly.
