



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Alt** = Alternate

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sc2tog** = (Draw up a loop in next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" x 90" [25.5 x 228.5 cm], excluding tassels

## GAUGES

7 sc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].

2 Wedges = Approx 5" x 10" [12.5 x 25.5 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** To maintain consistent color changes, join new ball of yarn to match last color change of previous ball. This will help to ensure stripe repeat will match as closely as possible.

Ch 21 (multiple of 4 ch + 1).

**Foundation row:** (WS). Working into horizontal "bump" at back of each ch, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end of chain. 20 sc.

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to last 4 sc. Turn, leaving rem sts unworked. 16 sc.

**2nd and alt rows:** Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** As 1st row. 12 sc.

**5th row:** As 1st row. 8 sc.

**7th row:** As 1st row. 4 sc.

**9th row:** Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each of first 4 sc. (Sc2tog, working into side of last st of previous row and back loop

## MATERIALS

Caron® Sprinkle Cakes™ (8 oz/227 g; 193 yds/176 m)

Red Velvet (23003)

**3 balls**

Size U.S. L11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
4" [10 cm] wide piece of cardboard for Tassels. Tapestry needle.

only of next st 2 rows below. 1 sc in back loop only of each of next 3 sc) 4 times. Turn. 20 sc.

First Wedge complete.

Rep 1st to 9th rows until Scarf measures approx 90" [228.5 cm], ending on 9th row of an even numbered Wedge.

**Next row:** As 2nd row.

Fasten off.

**Tassels (make 10):** Cut a piece of cardboard 4" [10 cm] wide. Wind yarn around cardboard 30 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 1" [2.5 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Sew 5 Tassels evenly spaced to each end of Scarf.
